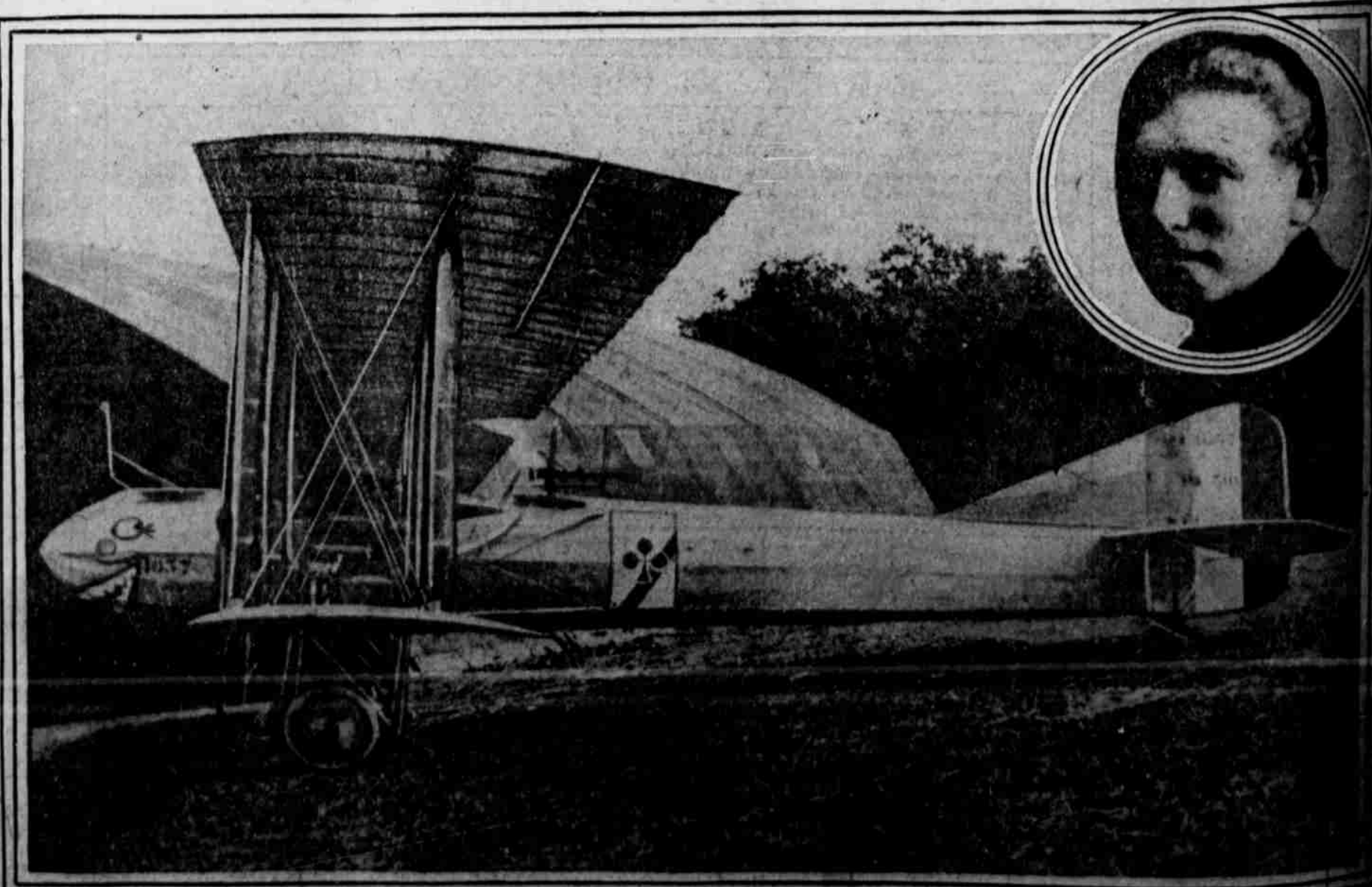

 Great Britain is now ringing with praises for Lieutenant Brandon, who performed an additionally astonishing feat in attacking the huge German bag so that it could be photographed.
