

**VENTI CANNONI MEDII PRESI DAGLI ITALIANI. AD EST DEL VALLONE**

Il Cattivo Tempo Ostacola Per fino le Azioni di Artiglieria. Von Mackensen E' Costretto a Ripiegare

**BRUSILOFF OTTIMISTA**

ROMA, 10 Novembre. Durante l'offensiva della settimana scorsa da parte degli italiani sul campo le forze del generale Cadorna presso al nemico dei cannoni, come annunziava il Ministero della Guerra. I tredici di questi cannoni sono di medio calibro, in gran parte da 105 millimetri.

Sull'intera fronte di battaglia si ebbero nella giornata di ieri soltanto alcuni intermitteni di cattivo tempo. Furono ostacolati da cattivo tempo, dal Carso un'altra batteria di tre cannoni da 145 millimetri, con una grande quantità di munizioni, e' stato preso dagli italiani. Questa batteria era stata abbandonata dagli austriaci sul Monte Pecinka quando ne furono cacciati dalle forze nostre.

Le forze russo-rumene operanti nella Dobraea sono sull'offensiva contro le forze tedesche, bulgare e turche del maresciallo von Mackensen. Questa e' stato costretto ad indietreggiare per circa dodici miglia dalla vigorosa offensiva del russo-rumeno che sono comandati dal famoso generale russo Sakaroff che si era distinto nella recente campagna in Gallia. Le forze di von Mackensen sono state cacciate non soltanto da Hirsowa e dalla riva del Danubio, dove erano appoggiati da una squadriglia di cannonieri austriaci, ma anche da Topal che dopo aver trucidato la ferrovia Costanza-Appen, i tedeschi dalla ferrovia Costanza-Cernavoda.

Nel tempo stesso le truppe russe operano sull'offensiva nella parte nord-orientale della Transilvania dove hanno gia' ottenuto successi contro le truppe austro-tedesche nella regione di Dorna Vatra.

Sembra che sia l'intenzione dello Stato Maggiore russo quella di concentrare il massimo sforzo nella Rumania nell'autunno e nell'inverno, così da evitare la minaccia di una invasione austro-tedesca-bulgara dei paesi moldo-valacchi. Nel tempo stesso il Comando russo organizzerà le sue forze sulle fronti della Gallia e della Polonia in vista di avervi in primavera un esercito fortissimo e ricco di munizioni e di materiale di artiglieria, pronto a prendere l'offensiva al primo cenno da parte degli Stati Maggiori dell'Intesa.

Il generale Brusiloff, parlando con un editore del Times di Londra, ha detto che i rumeni devono aver fede nella Russia che risparmiara' loro la sorte dei serbi. Egli disse che lo sforzo teutonico e vano e che le sorti della guerra non potranno essere favorevoli alle potenze centrali.

**GRAVE RENT DUE, CORPSES MAY BE SENT TO BONEYARD**

City of Buenos Aires Warns Delinquent Relatives of Dead

BUENOS AIRES, Nov. 10.—The leasing of graves being, to a considerable extent, the custom in Buenos Aires, the municipal intendente has published a notice warning the relatives of tenants in the local cemeteries that rents are due and that those who fail to obtain renewals within thirty days will be evicted.

The intendente adds that victims of the evictions will be deposited in the charnel house, or, less elegantly expressed, the general boneyard.

The thirty days are now about up. A good deal of the rent has been paid, but there is still a good-sized list of delinquents. Their ejection from their graves is expected to begin shortly.
