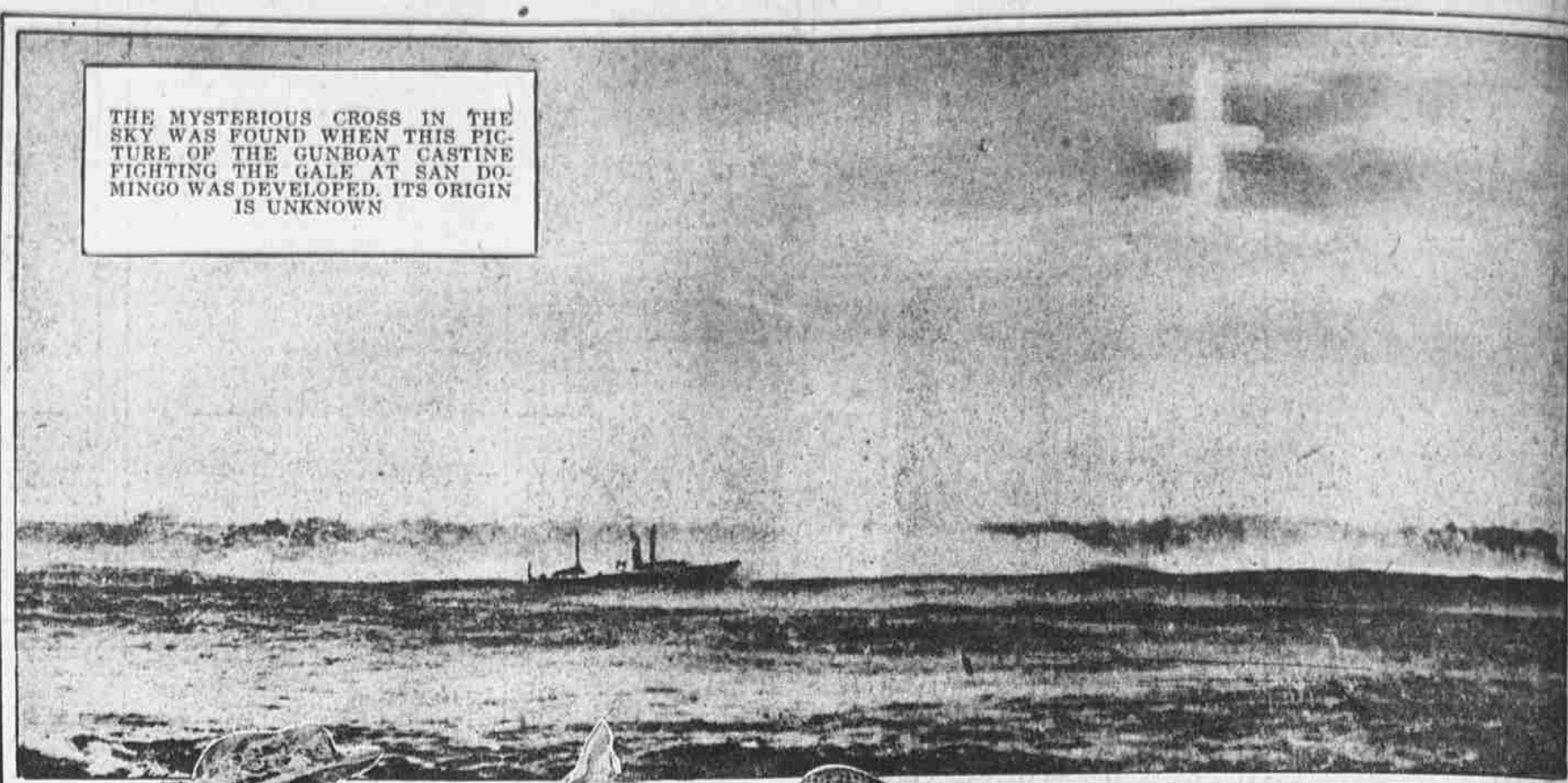




UNKNOWN HERO OF THE CRUISER MEMPHIS'S WRECK

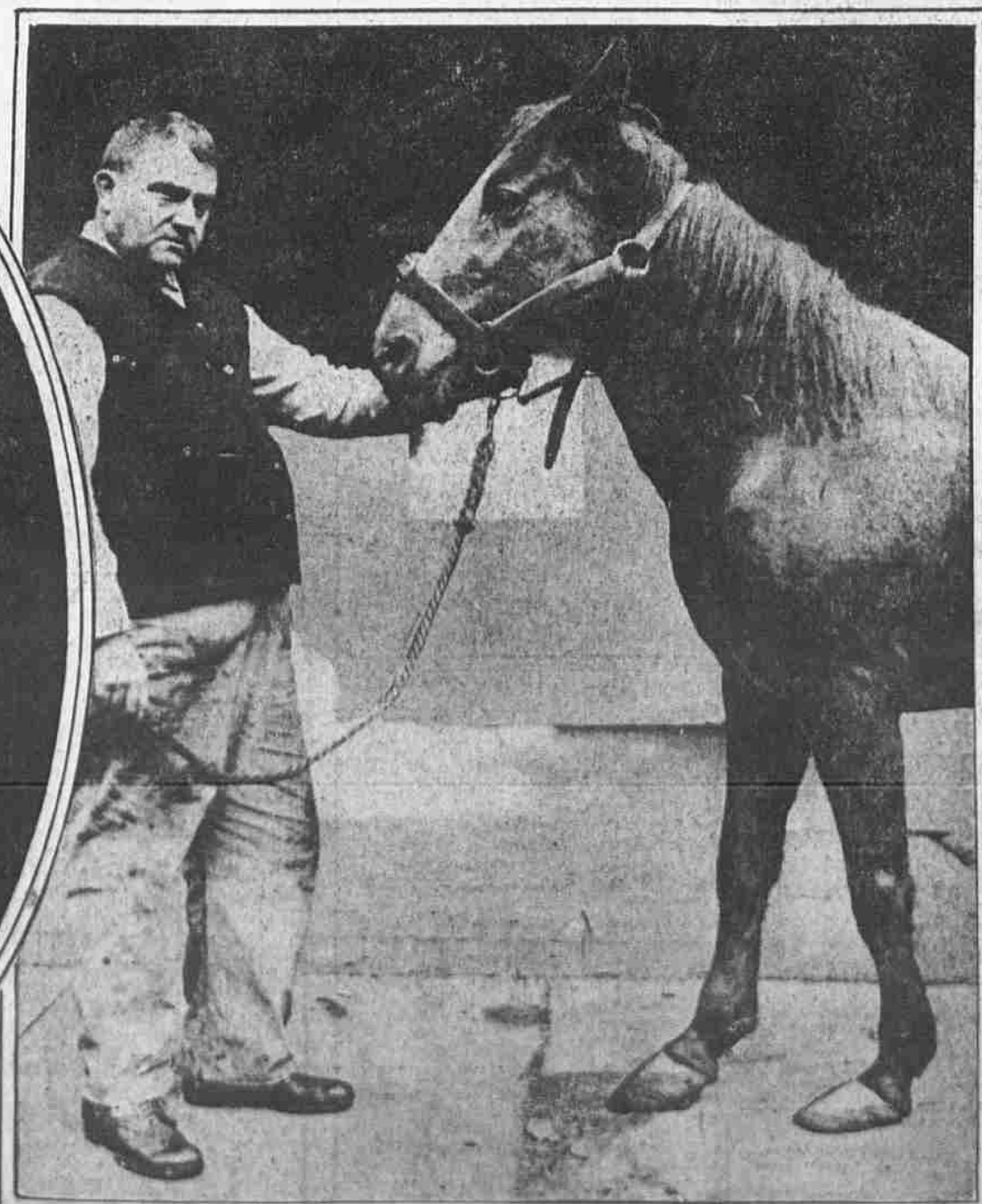
