

FURTHER GAIN IN LAKE SUPERIOR STOCK IN LOCAL EXCHANGE TRADING

Further improvement in the price of Lake Superior Corporation stock was registered with the opening of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange this morning.

Fractional gains were recorded in a number of stocks among them being Philadelphia Rapid Transit trust certificates.
