Caribbeans, goods from Turkey, Russia and Central India, iron-ore from Cuba and South American countries, manganese ore from Germany and Brazil, nitrates from Peru, sulphur from Chile, tobacco from Cuba, Sumatra and Java, wool from every wool-producing country in the world, especially from distant Australia, and sugar from the West Indian and Hawaiian Islands, which is brought to this port in a raw state in enormous quantities, refined in the big refineries on our wharves and reexported all over the United States.

TO THE NORTH FROM THE PORT OF PHILADELPHIA this water traffic system will connect with all points on Long Island Sound, through the Cape Cod Canal, Massachusetts Bay, Boston Harbor and New England points and also by way of the Hudson River and the New York Barge Canal, now almost completed, connections can be made with Lakes Champlain, Erie and Ontario, in fact with the whole of the Great Lakes system.

"OLD IRONSIDES" FORESCORE AND FIVE

Locomotive Made Initial Trip to Germantown 85 Years Ago Today

Eighty-five years ago today, "old Ironsides," the first successful steam locomotive in this country, appeared in Philadelphia, and to the amusement of the population ran "smoothly" and "quite wonderfully" between this city and Germantown, a distance of six miles, over the track of the Philadelphia, Germantown and Norristown Railroad Company.

At the time of the general interest in moving engines, Baldwin had become quite successful in the agency that brought the first locomotive into existence. Strictly speaking, "old Ironsides" was not the first. For some time earlier Englishmen had been experimenting with steam locomotives, but their results were not very fruitful. A few were built and imported to this country, but in the long run they proved a failure.

DELaware & BAYWATER CANAL, which at present leaves the Delaware River at Bordertown, passes through Trenton and New Brunswick, and by way of Haddon River and Bay to New York, may be supplemented by another canal recommended by United States army engineers, leading from Burlington directly across New Jersey alongside the present canal to the terminus at Morgan, N. J., near South Amboy, on Haritan Bay, and thence to New York. This canal is to be called the New Jersey Ship Canal.

CONNECTIONS WITH FAR POINTS
To the north from the port of Philadelphia this water traffic system will connect with all points on Long Island Sound, through the Cape Cod Canal, Massachusetts Bay, Boston Harbor and New England points and also by way of the Hudson River and the New York Barge Canal, now almost completed, connections can be made with Lakes Champlain, Erie and Ontario, in fact with the whole of the Great Lakes system.

CHESAPEAKE & DELAWARE CANAL, leaves the Delaware River at Delaware City, passes across the Delaware and Maryland peninsulas to Chesapeake Bay, giving a direct water route from Philadelphia to Baltimore.

Fronte del Trentino—L'artiglieria e' stata attiva. Il fuoco accurato delle nostre batterie ha disturbato importanti movimenti di truppe nemiche sulle retrovie ed ha colpito la piattaforma di una batteria nemica.

Fronte delle Alpi Giulie—L'attivita' delle artiglierie e' stata ostacolata dal cattivo tempo che pero' non ha interrotto punto la solita attivita' dei nostri reparti di ricognizione.

D'ANNUNZIO DECORATO.
Un telegramma da Venezia dice che la croce di guerra francese e' stata attaccata al petto del capitano di cavalleria Gabriel d'Annunzio, che per l'occasione porta anche le insegne del ferito. Come e' noto il poeta perdetto un occhio in un accidente capitogli mentre discendeva col suo aeroplano dopo essere ritornato da una spedizione sulle linee nemiche.
