



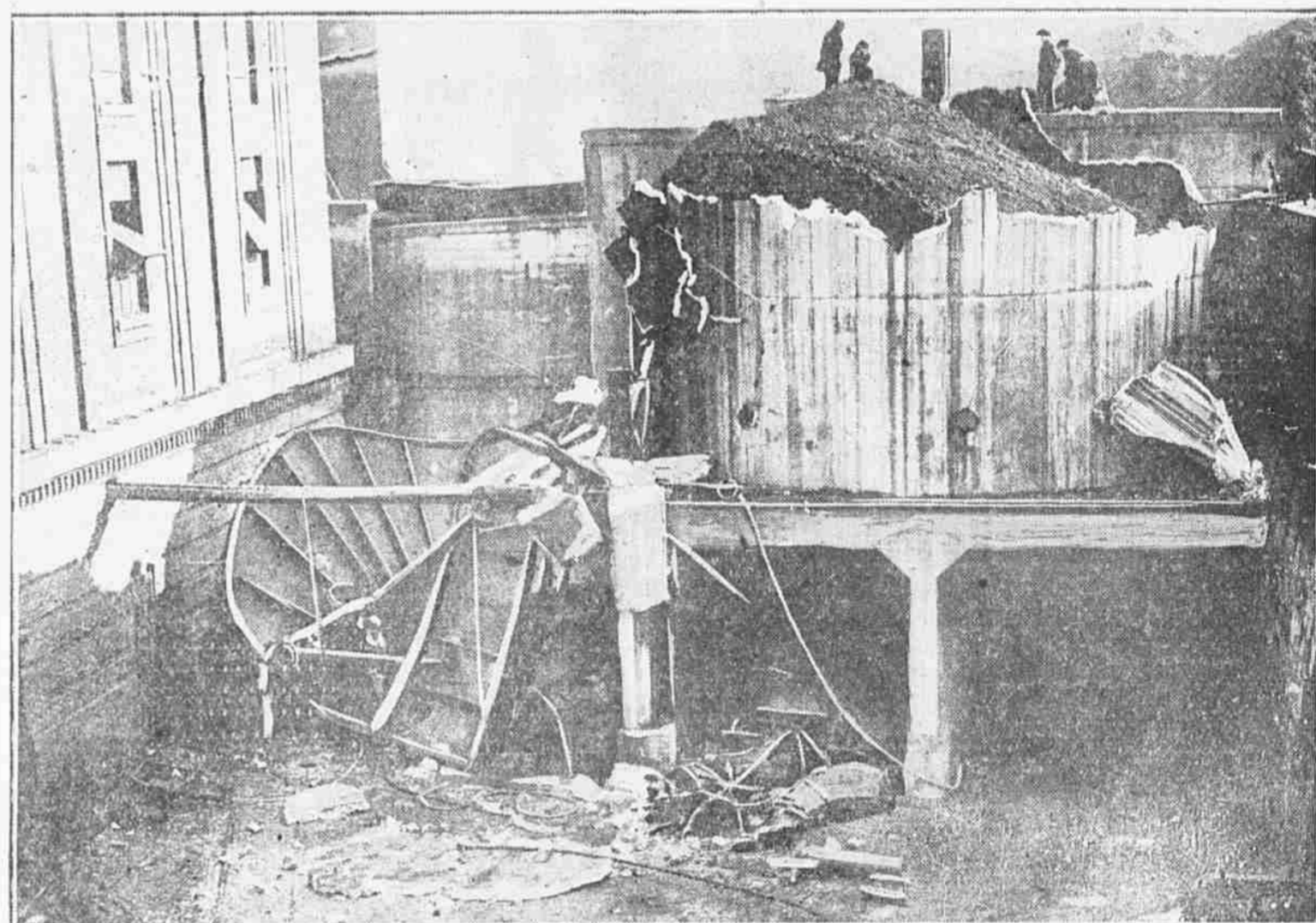

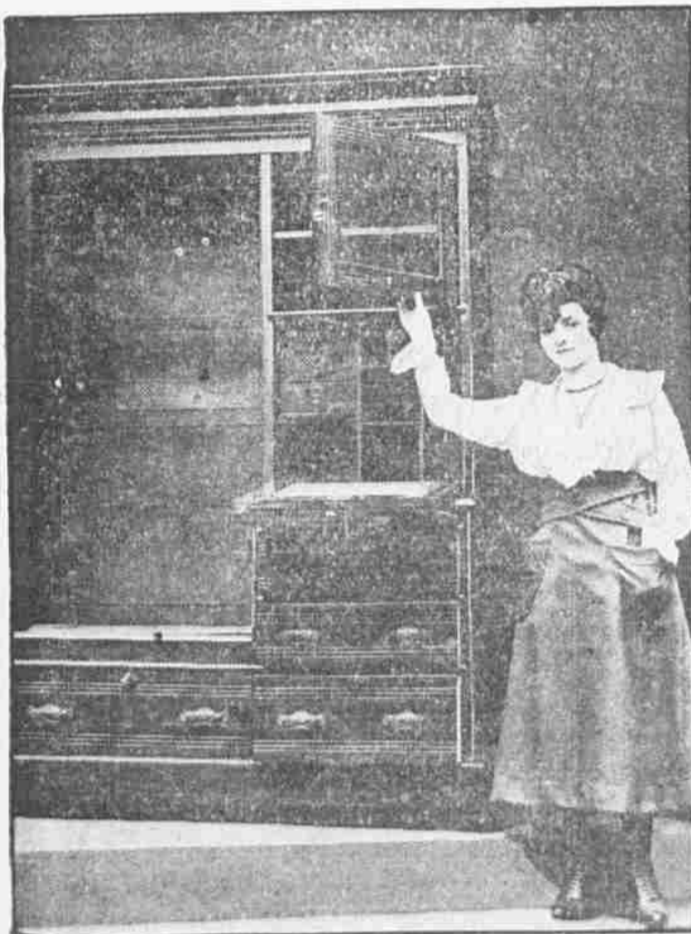
MANY PRETTY MAIDS IN THE RANKS OF THE STRIKING GARMENT WORKERS

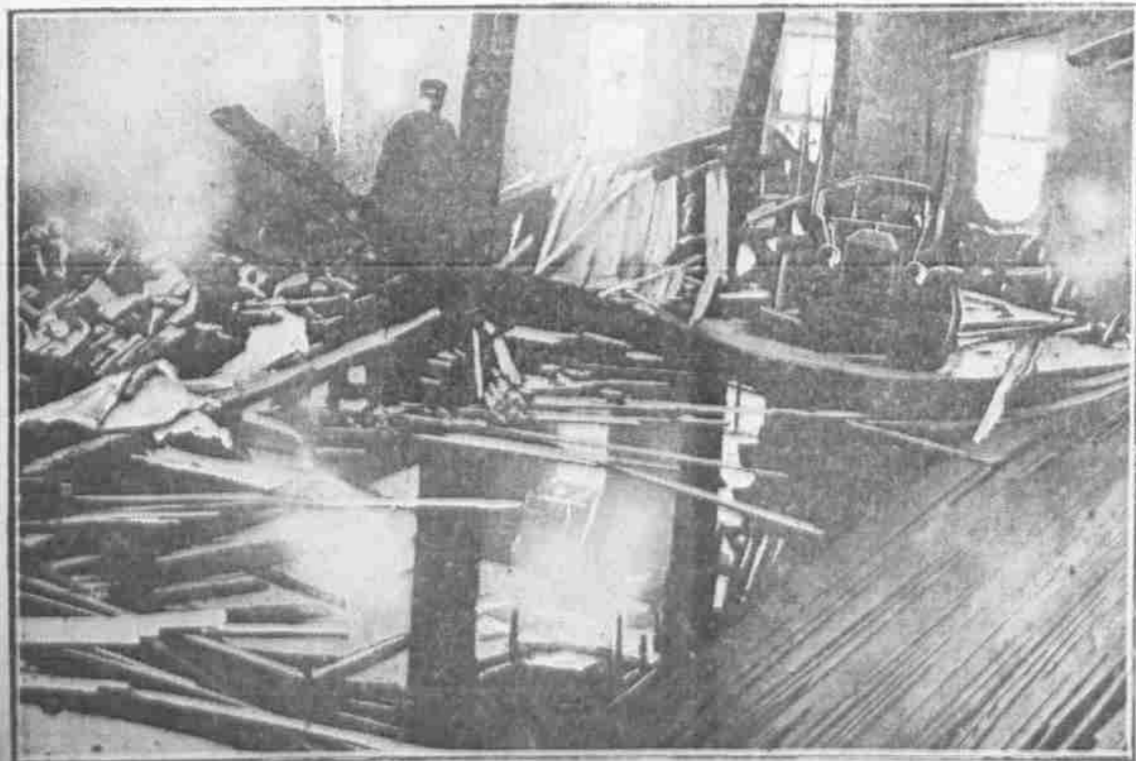
