## Miss Jane Erwin Bell

After an illness extending over a period of two years, Miss Jane Erwin Bell, a daughter of the late John Bell, who in 1860 was a member of Congress, died at her residence, 121 Chestnut Hill. Miss Bell was seventy-nine years old. The two sisters settled in Chestnut Hill and established a private school, known as "Spring-side," shortly after their father was defeated for the presidency. The school was conducted fifteen years ago, when the two sisters moved to New Haven since lived together. At the time their father was a candidate for President, he received the electoral votes of Kentucky, Tennessee and Virginia. He lived in Newark and was nominated by the Constitutional party.

## Mrs. Mary R. Taylor

Mrs. Mary Radcliffe Taylor, wife of Joseph Taylor of Norristown, and mother of Mrs. William Barnes Lower of Wynnewood, died at midnight last night at her home in Norristown, after a prolonged illness of a complication of diseases. She was sixty-eight years old. Her husband, now Taylor, for many years has been identified with the manufacturing interests of Norristown and Bridgeport. Mrs. Taylor, the only surviving child, is the wife of the Rev. Dr. William Barnes Lower, pastor of the Calvary Presbyterian Church of Wynnewood, moderator of the Presbytery of Philadelphia North and founder of Calvary Mission, at Linckleman's and Washington lane Germantown.
