LANCASTER, Pa., Feb. 12.—The Rev. Dr. Frederick Augustus Gast, of the Reform Church and a teacher of Hebrew and Old Testament science in Franklin and Marshall Theological Seminary, was found dead in bed. For many years, Doctor Gast has been professor emeritus. He was a member of the Society of Bible Archaeology, London Bible Society and the Religious Education Society. He was chaplain of the Forty-fifth Pennsylvania Volunteers during the Civil War. He was born in 1836.
