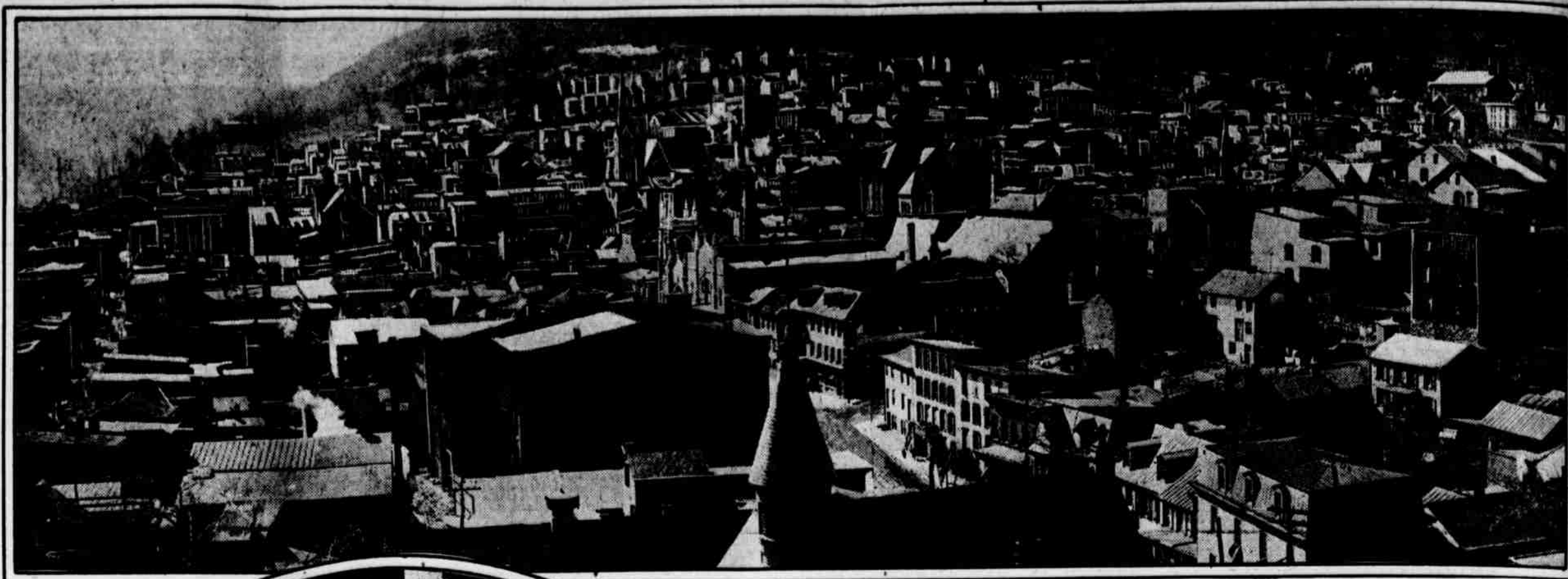

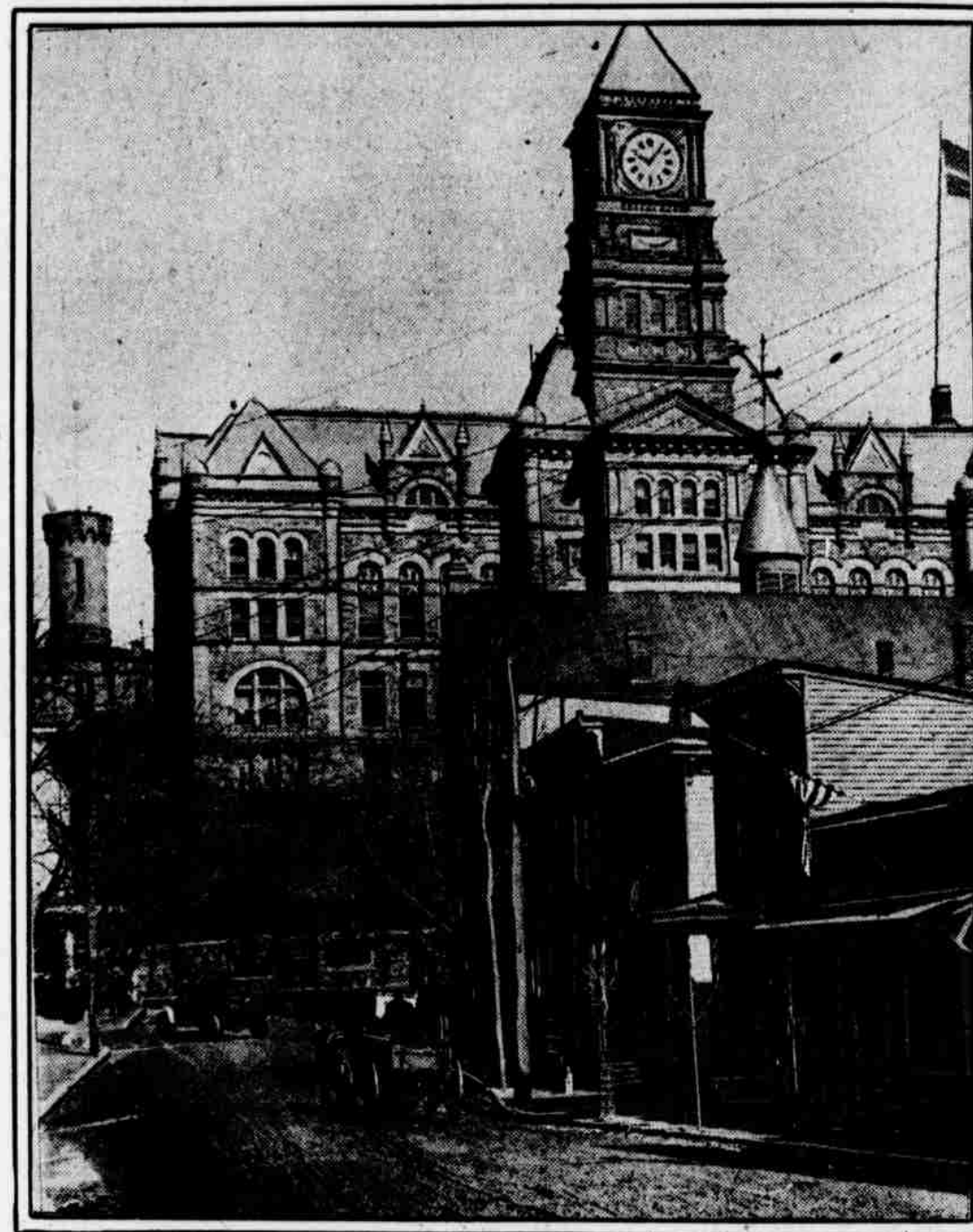
**POTTSVILLE BOASTS THE YOUNGEST MAYOR IN THE STATE**  
He is F. Pierce Mortimer, and when elected four years ago had just passed his twenty-ninth birthday.



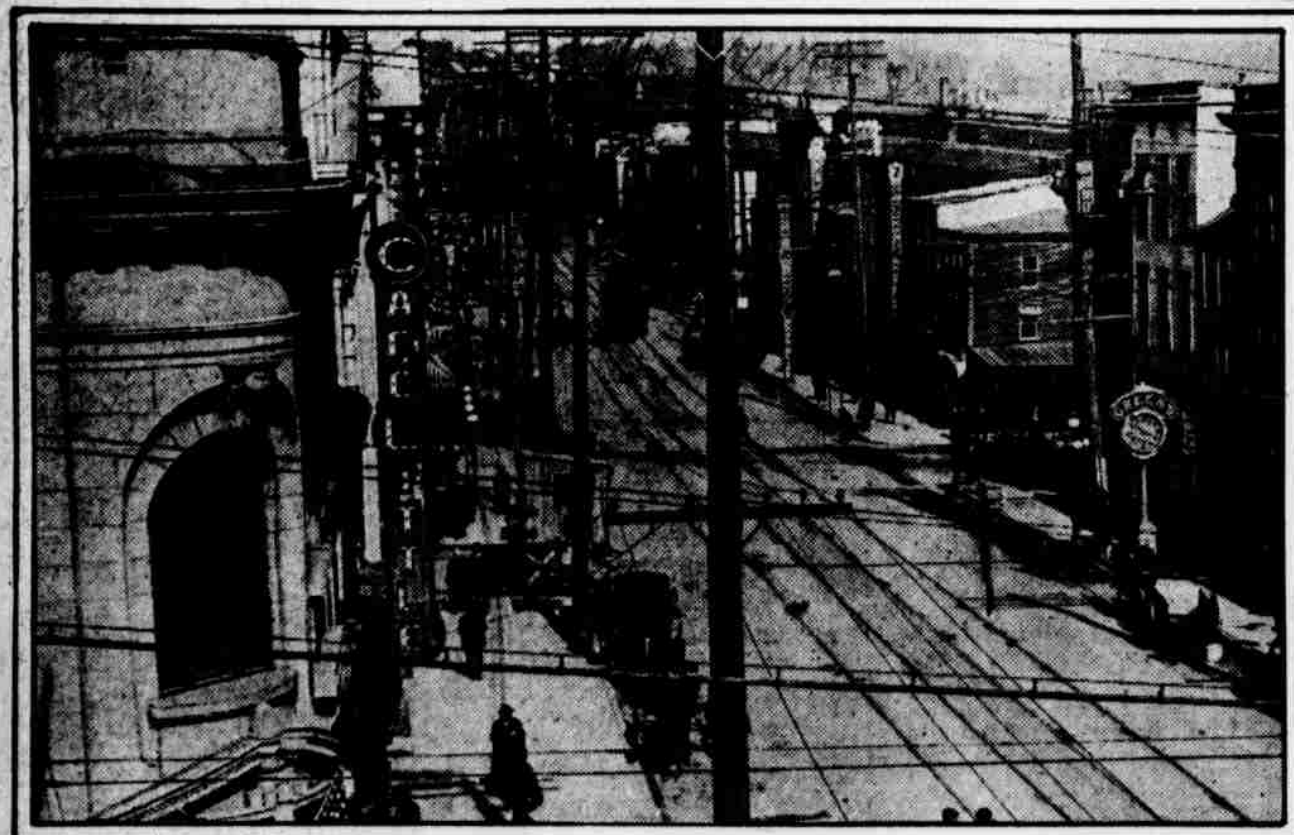
**THE CITY, LINING THE SLUGGISH SCHUYLKILL, STANDS UPON A ROCK**  
Built above the river's coal-laden banks, Pottsville's homes and business houses rest over concealed millions in precious anthracite.



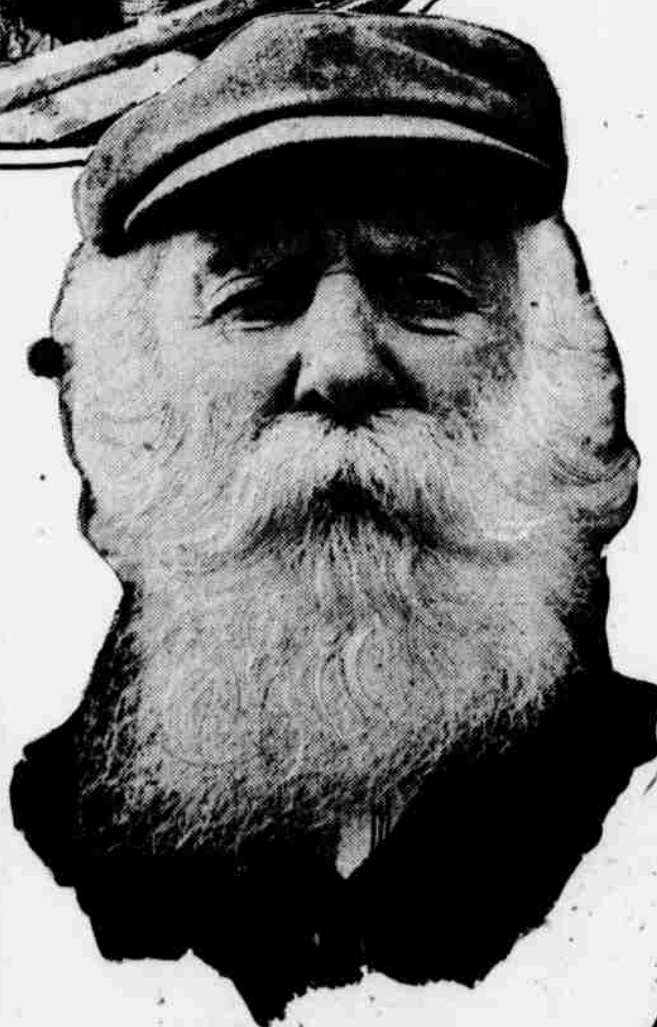
**MANY A COAL MAGNATE BEGAN IN THIS WAY**
