Il Governo di Vienna Ha Rotto le Relazioni Diplomatiche con gli Stati Uniti

CUBA E' IN GUERRA

Il Brasile alla Vigilia di Dichiarare la Guerra alla Germania per Un Piroscampo Affondato

WASHINGTON, 10 Aprile.

Anche l'Austria ha rotto le sue relazioni diplomatiche con gli Stati Uniti. Non esiste ancora stato di guerra tra Austria e Stati Uniti, ma questo sarà inevitabile non appena un sottomarino austriaco farà un atto di ostilità verso i piroscafi americani e non appena forse americani si troveranno a contatto con forze austriache. Intanto la rottura, che è venuta da Vienna, ha fatto saltare il piano di pace che il Dipartimento di Stato sperava di fare. Il piano prevedeva che si trovasse un modo agli agenti segreti di sorvegliare anche le spie austriache e togliere alla spie tedesche un ricovero nei consoli austro-ungarici.

Il ministro di Svezia a Washington ha assunto la protezione degli interessi austro-ungarici in America.

Il governo cubano, appoggiato dal Congresso che nel suo voto è stato unanime, ha dichiarato la guerra alla Germania. Nel tempo medesimo il Brasile e, si può dire, alla vigilia di seguire gli Stati Uniti, gli altri sottomarini brasiliani. Il Parana, fondato un pirata brasiliano, il Parana, ed il popolo domanda la guerra alla Germania. Si crede che gli Stati Uniti saranno seguiti anche da altre repubbliche del Sud America.

Qui proseguono i preparativi per l'entrata effettiva degli Stati Uniti nella guerra contro gli imperi centrali. E nel tempo stesso si giunge notizia che gli inglesi hanno iniziato un'altra prova offensiva, a nord di Arras ed a sud di Lens ed hanno sfondato la linea tedesca in quella regione per parecchie miglia. E continuano ancora l'offensiva a sud di Arras per sfondare la linea nemica da Cambrai a St. Quentin.

Il Senato approva, ieri, dopo una discussione di appena cinque minuti, una legge che commina la pena di trenta anni di carcere a chiunque distrugga materiale di guerra degli Stati Uniti in tempo di guerra.

ROMA, 10 Aprile.—Ieri l'altro a sera il Ministero della Guerra pubblicava il seguente rapporto del generale Cadorna circa la situazione alla fronte italiana:

Nella giornata di ieri si sono avuti i soli duelli di artiglieria. Le nostre batterie hanno bombardato stabilimenti militari nelle vicinanze di Mori. In Val d'Adige, ieri sera i nostri cannoni hanno fatto cadere una tonnellata di esplosivi sugli accampamenti nemici e depositi di munizioni nelle vicinanze di Rittenberg e di Mesari, nella valle della Brenta. Nonostante il violento fuoco delle batterie antiaeree, le nostre macchine hanno fatto cadere senza danni alle loro basi.

Questa mattina una squadriglia di idroceroplani nemici fece una incursione sulla costa di Montebelluna. Un cannone di artiglieria colpì la nave e la colpì anche, colpita dalle nostre batterie antiaeree, cadde nelle vicinanze di Casagliano. I due aerei che la montavano rimasero uccisi.

Pure ieri l'altro a sera il Ministero della Guerra pubblicava il seguente rapporto del generale Ameglio circa le operazioni contro i ribelli arabi della Tripolitania:

Le forze dei generali Cassini hanno sconfitto 5000 ribelli arabi nella zona di Suara ed hanno distrutto i loro accampamenti catturando quaranta caselli di artiglieria e gran quantità di munizioni e di bestiame ed una bandiera turca.

He has been various times manager of a real estate office, superintendent of a hosiery mill, foreman for a contractor, manager of a hotel, a bartender, driver, manager of a theatre, head waiter, lecturer for a sidewalk, painter, boss carpenter and a dentist's secretary.

At various times Jo has filled compulsory jobs working at the House of Correction. Feeling somewhat patriotic, he decided to raise an army of soldiers even as far as a recruiting station. Fay explained that he was a man of unusual abilities, but the Magistrate could not see just how that concerned the subject under discussion. He suggested that the man of such varied talent for a few weeks at Holmesburg-on-the-Delaware, where he would have out a plan for raising his prospective army.

Get Guns and Sabers in Raid
