RECRUITING SLUMP CONTINUES IN CITY

Less Than Fourth of 4000 Wanted for Army Here Enlisted
Enlistment 'Batting Averages' in 'Big League' Ball Towns

The figures above show the total army and marine corps enlistments yesterday, the total from April 1 to today and the number of enlistments per 1000 men of military age in the various cities.

WASHINGTON, April 25. Nevada is the first State to furnish her full quota of recruits to the United States army, the War Department announced today.

With twenty enlistments yesterday Nevada's total reached 173—seven more than her pro rata share of recruits.

Pennsylvania led in recruiting yesterday with 181 men. Illinois was next with 167, Michigan third with 145 and New York fourth with 107.

Illinois is still leading with a total of 3192 recruits since April 1. The recruiting slump in Philadelphia continued today.

The recruiting office here was there in satisfaction this morning and that was in the office of the Military Training and Administration, Commercial Trust Building, where 329 men have applied for the officers' training course at Fort Niagara.
