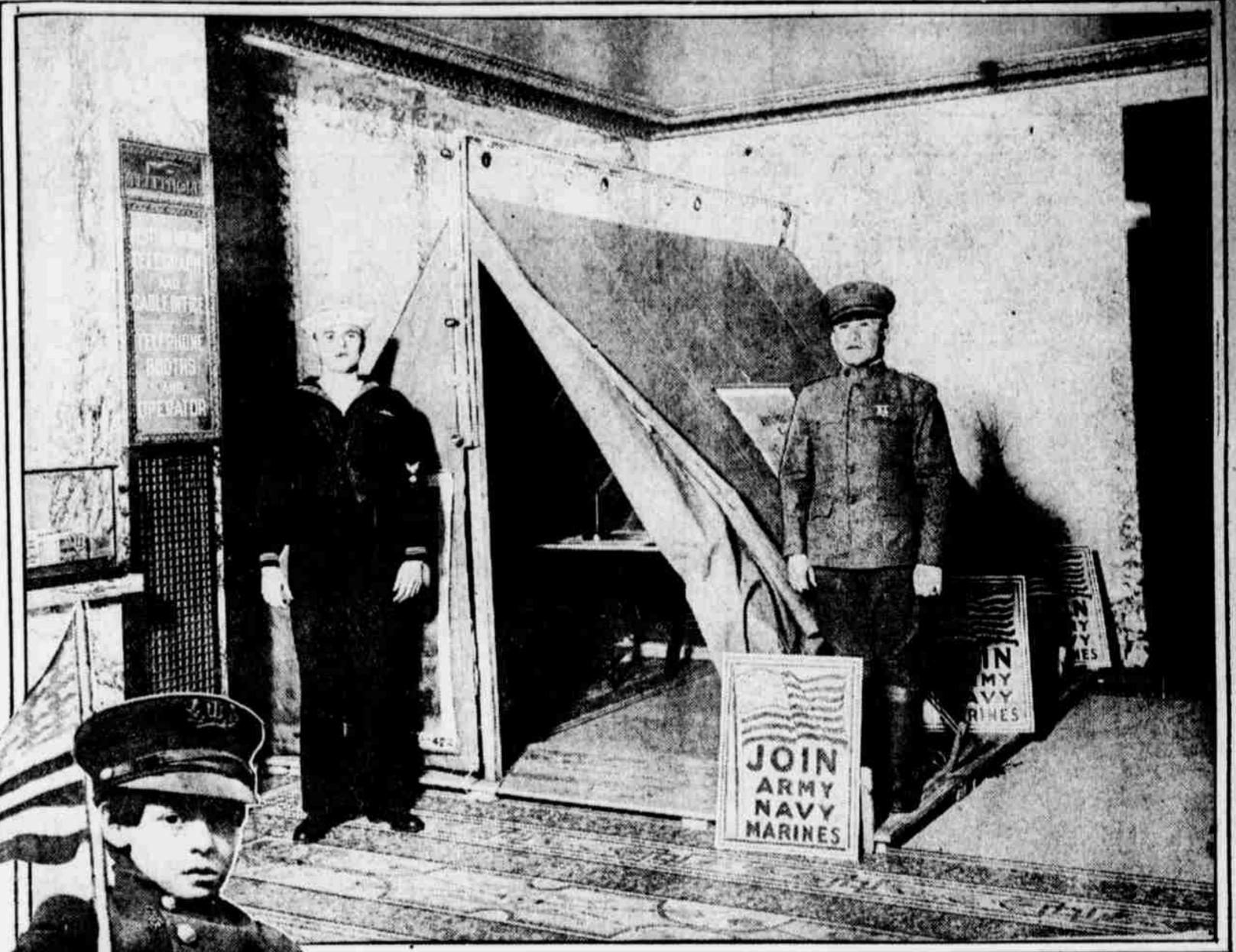




HISTORIC GERMANTOWN FURNISHES RECRUITS

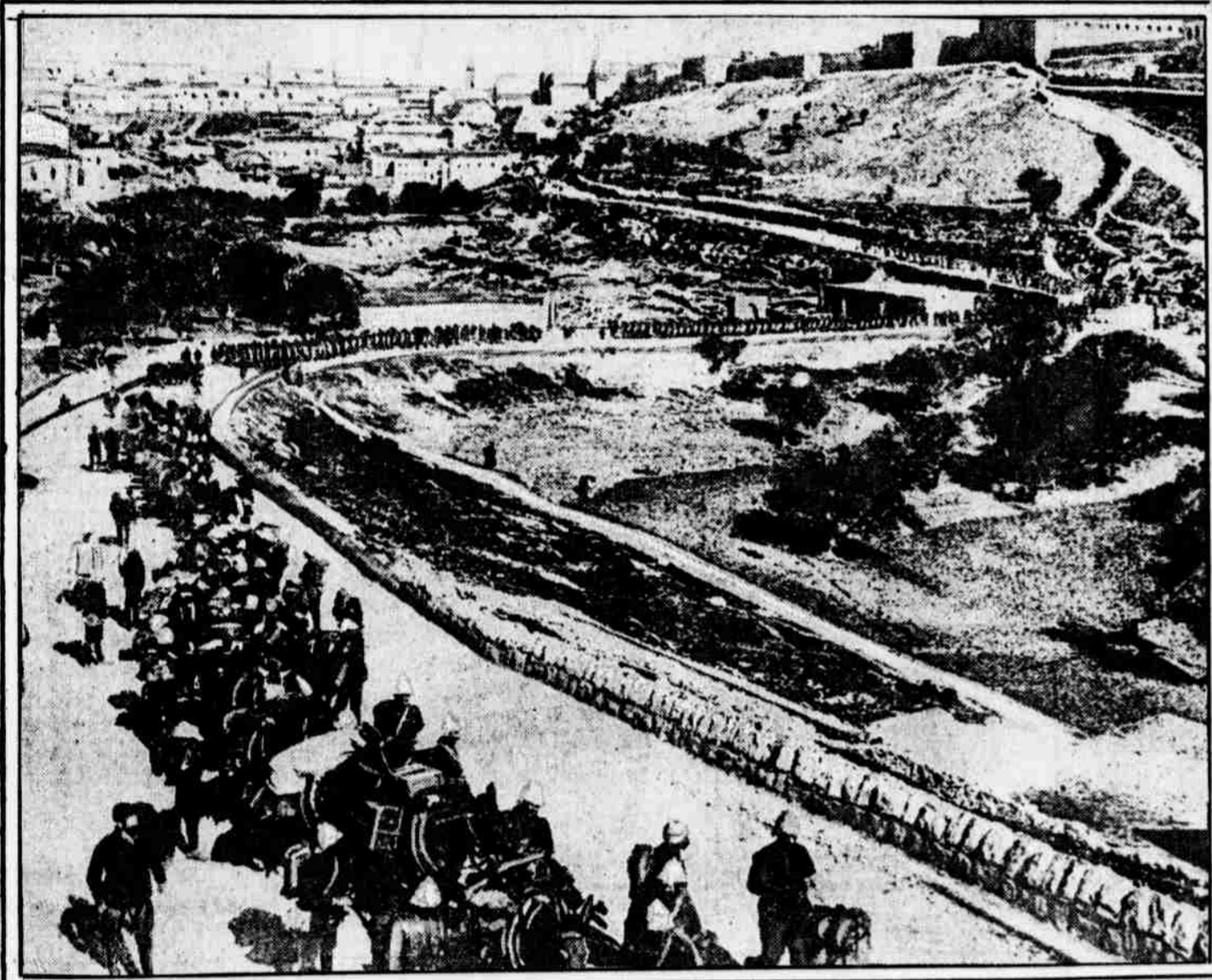
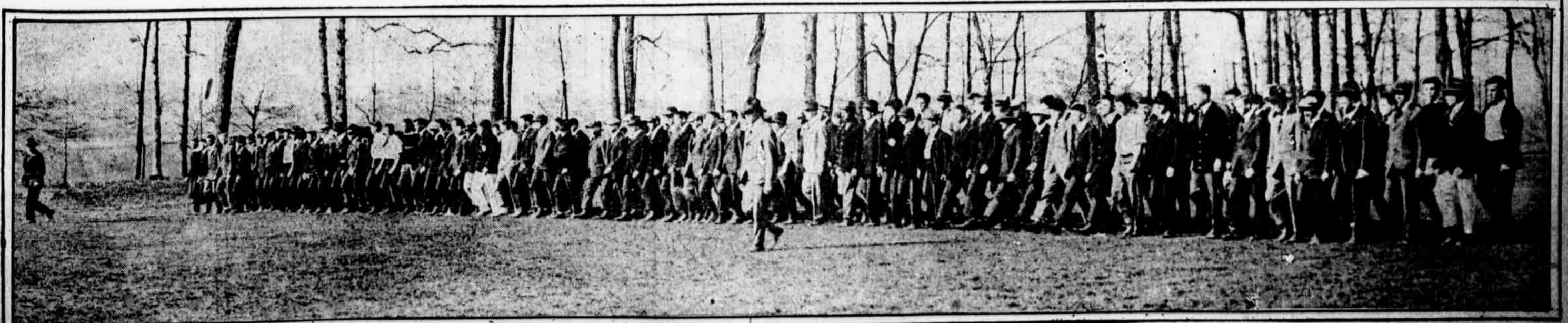
