

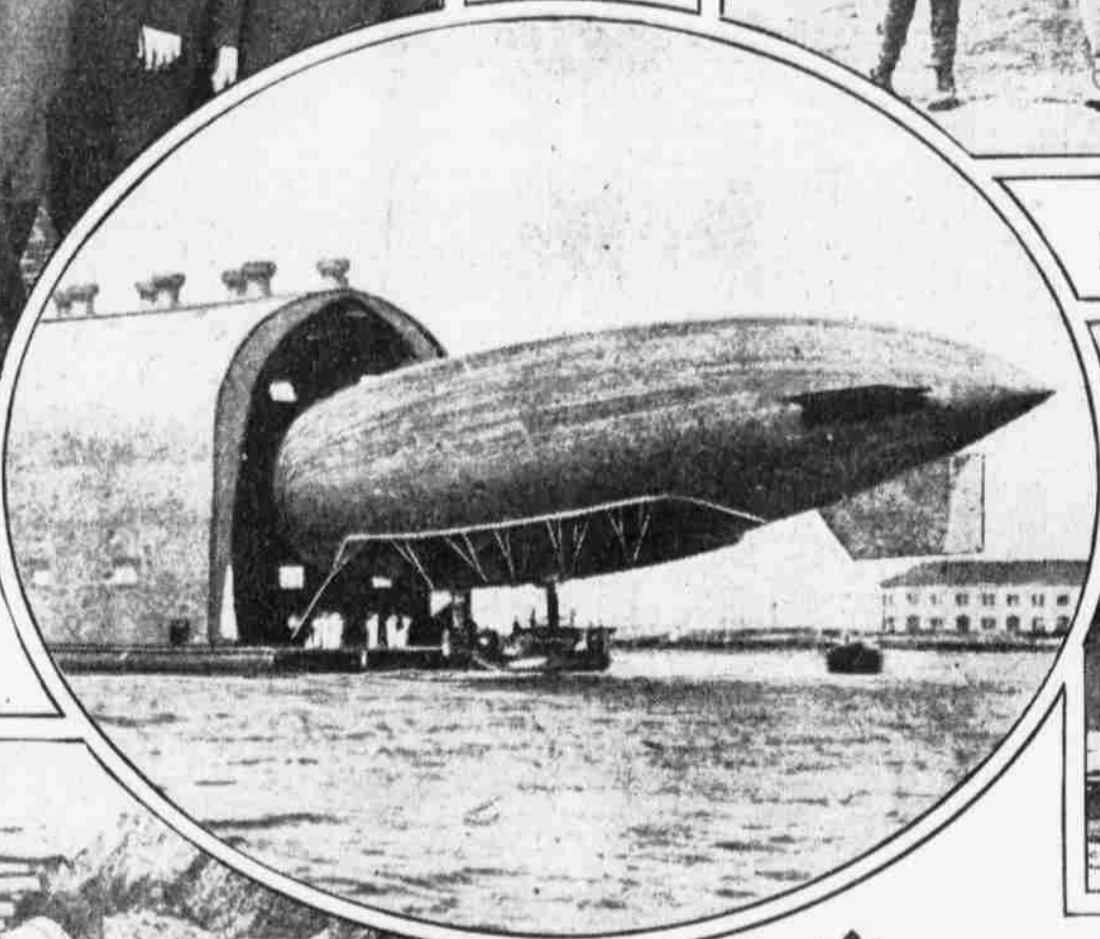

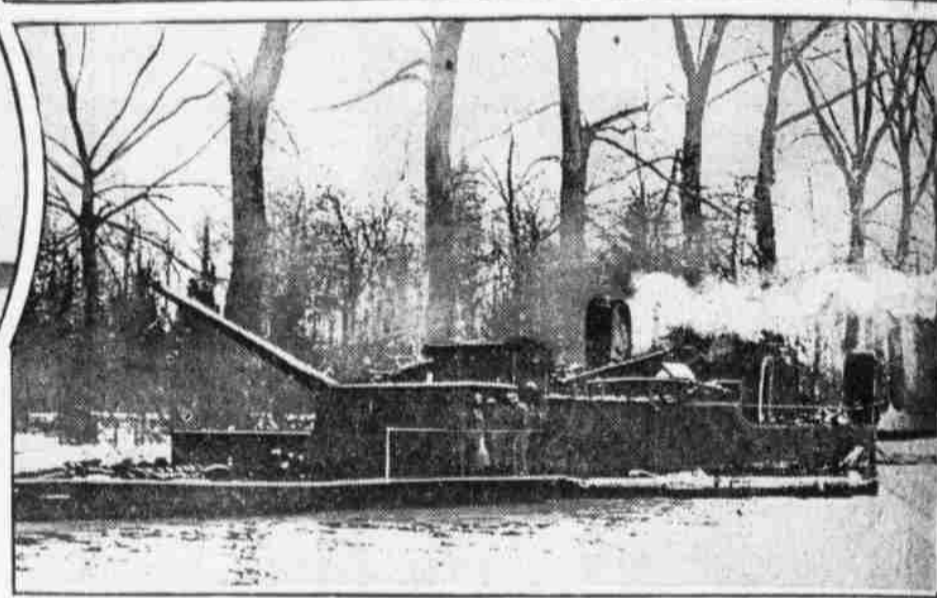
CHINESE UNIT TO FIGHT FOR UNCLE SAM

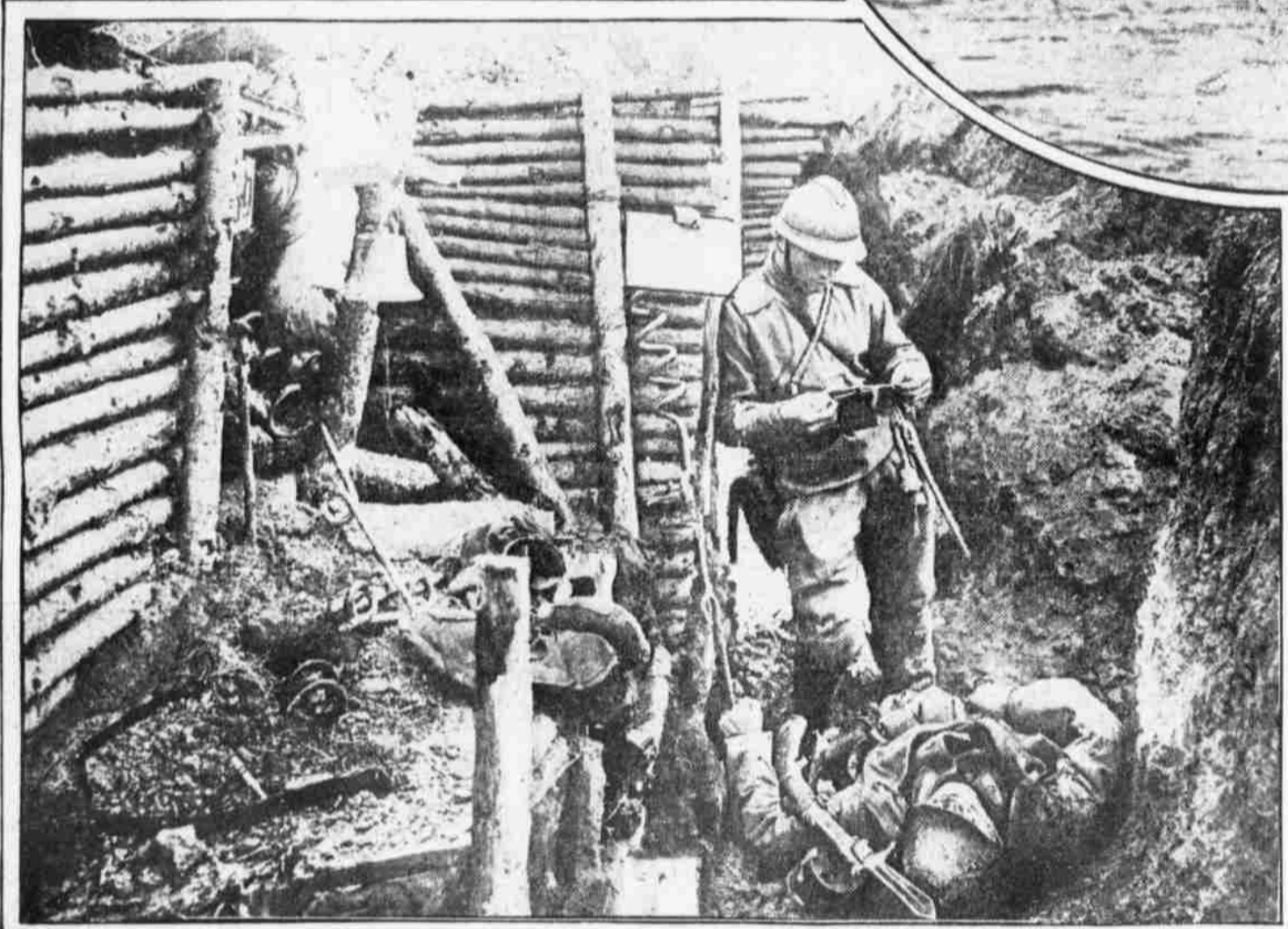
CIVILIANS NEAR BATTLE LINES WEAR GAS MASKS
The photograph shows members of a French family, who have clung to their home in the Aisne section, prepared to meet a gas attack of which they have been warned.



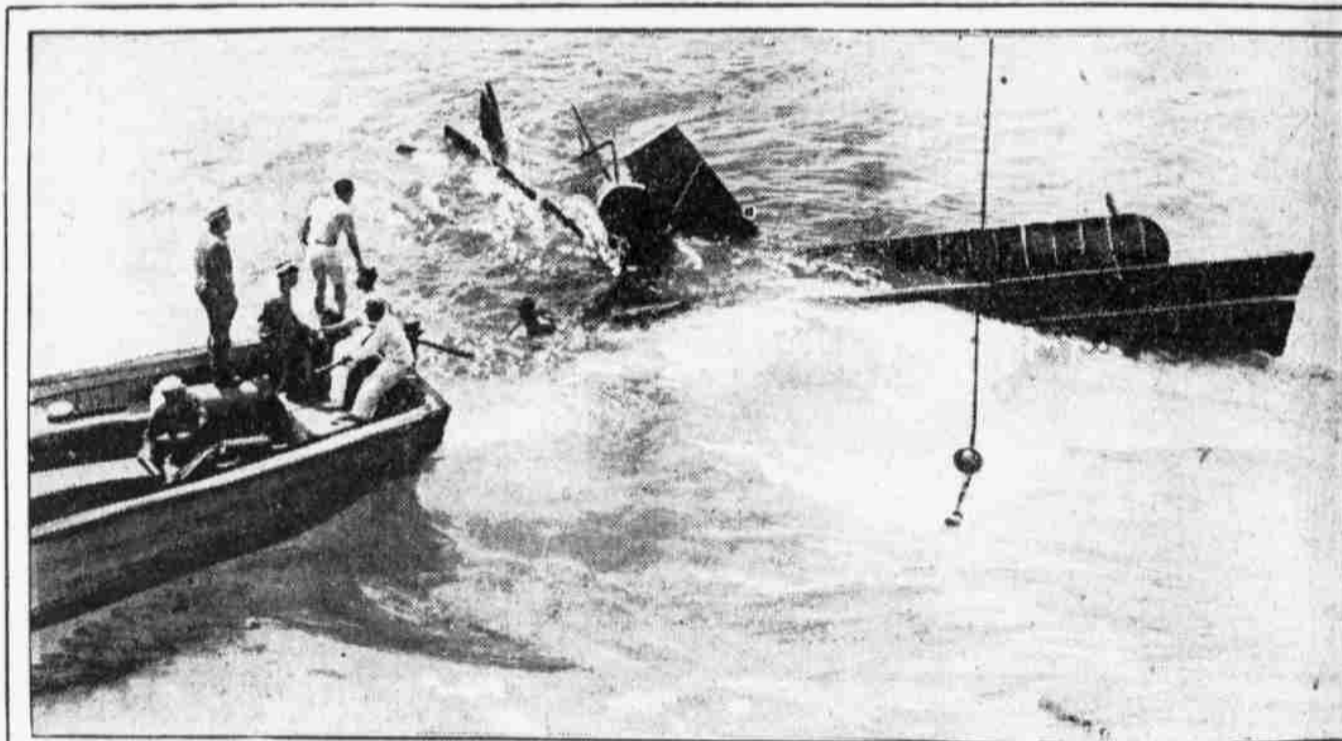

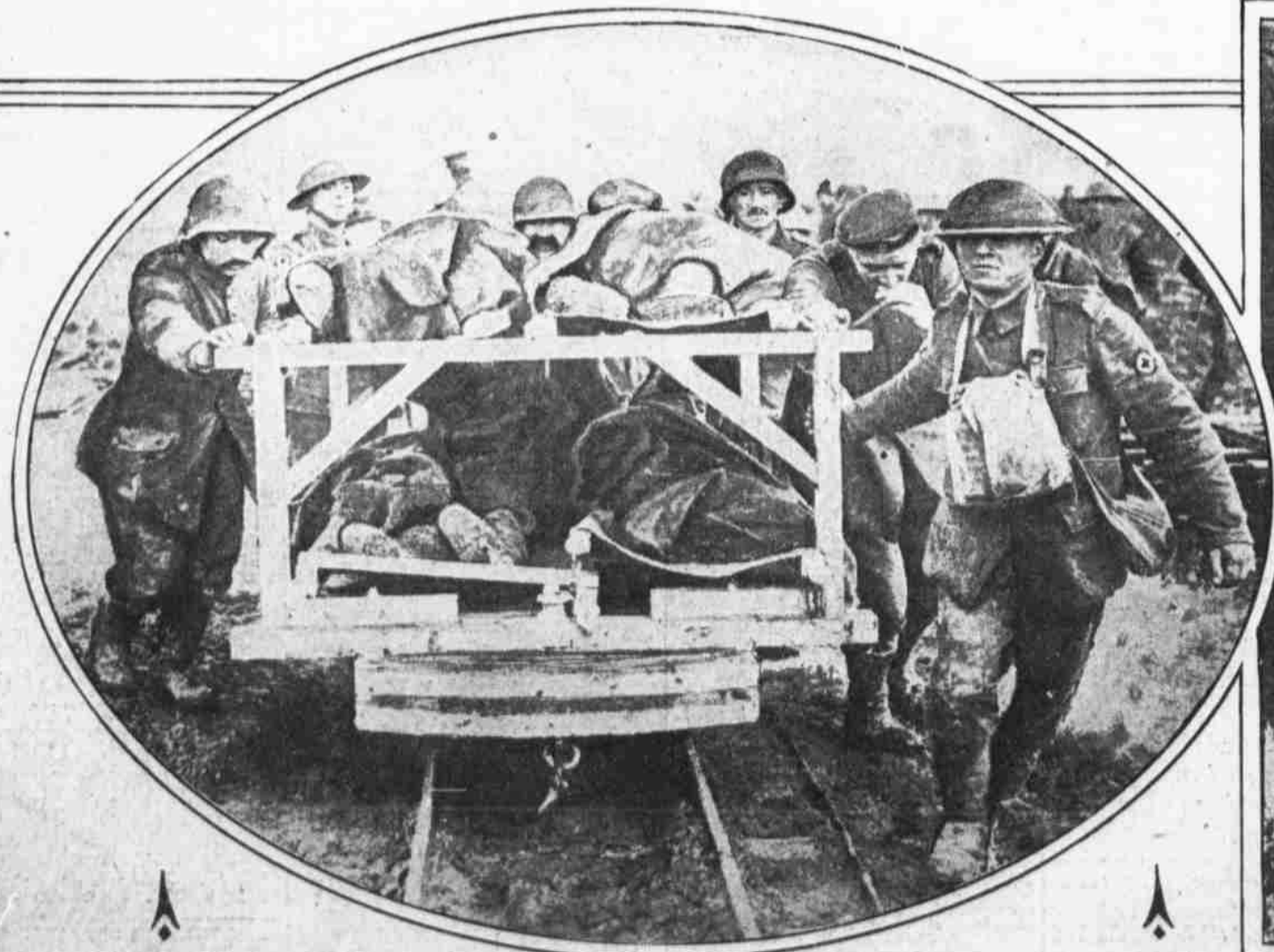
FRENCH GUNBOATS BOMBARD FOE FROM AISNE CANAL
