The Young Lady Across the Way

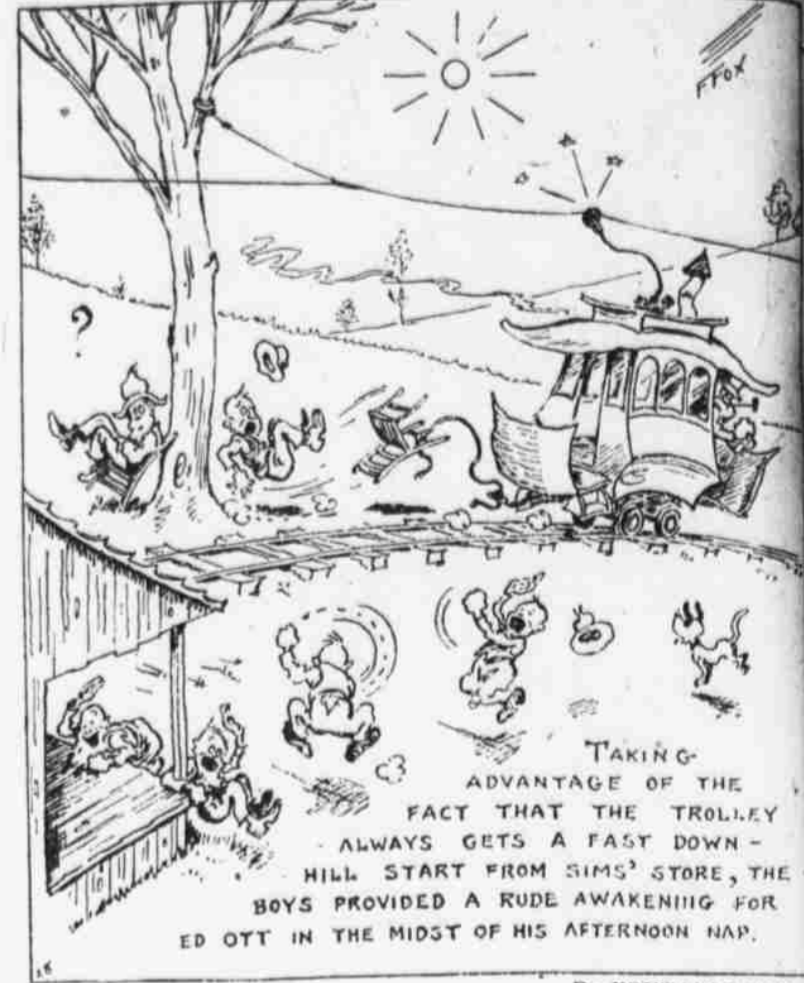

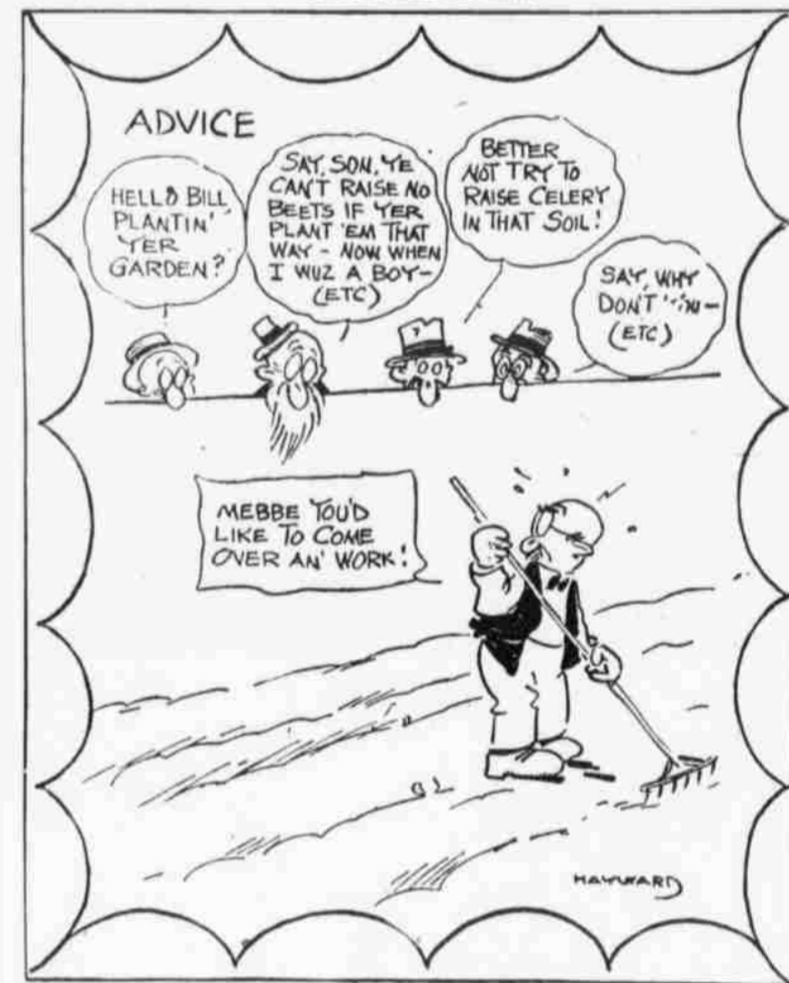
THE TOONERVILLE TROLLEY
