



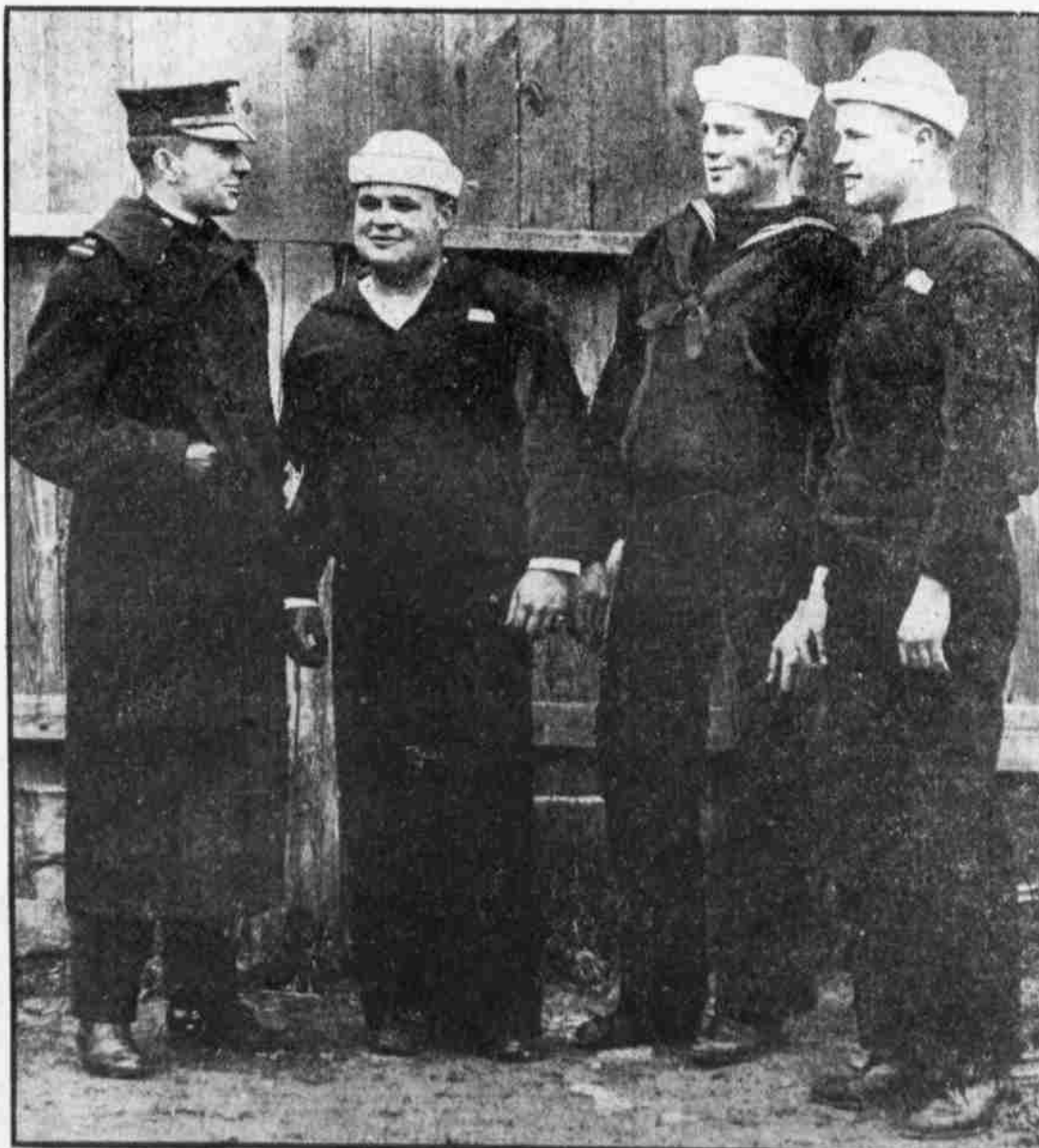

The young lady across the way says she didn't think so at first, but she's made up her mind that the fairest way to get volunteers is by conscription.

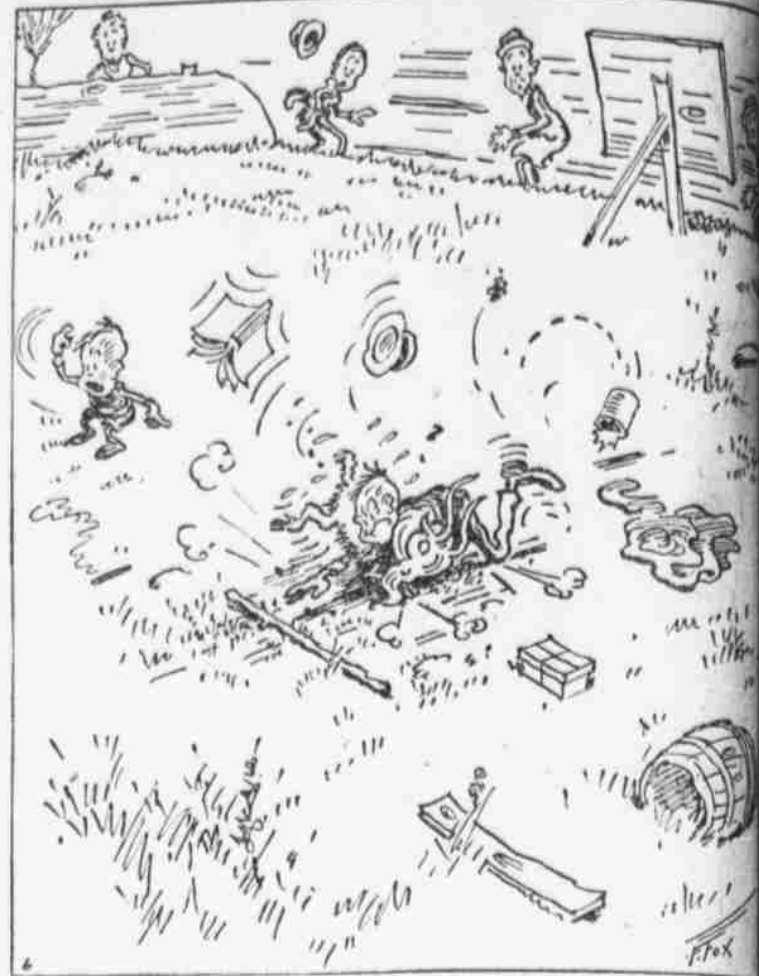

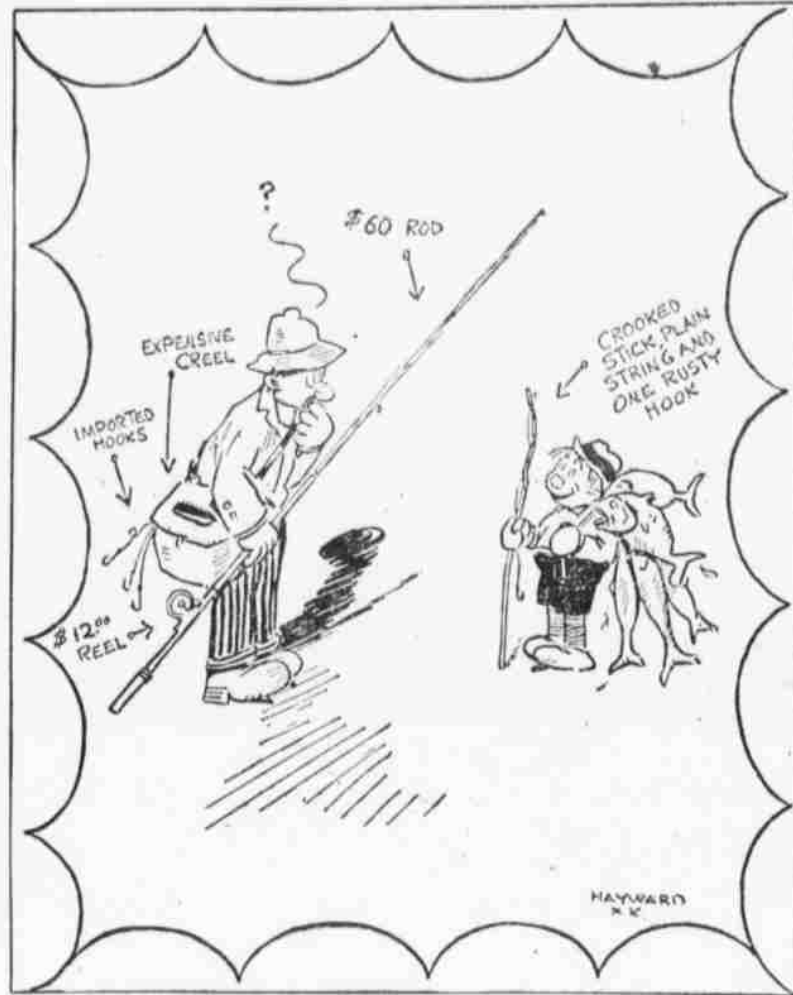
