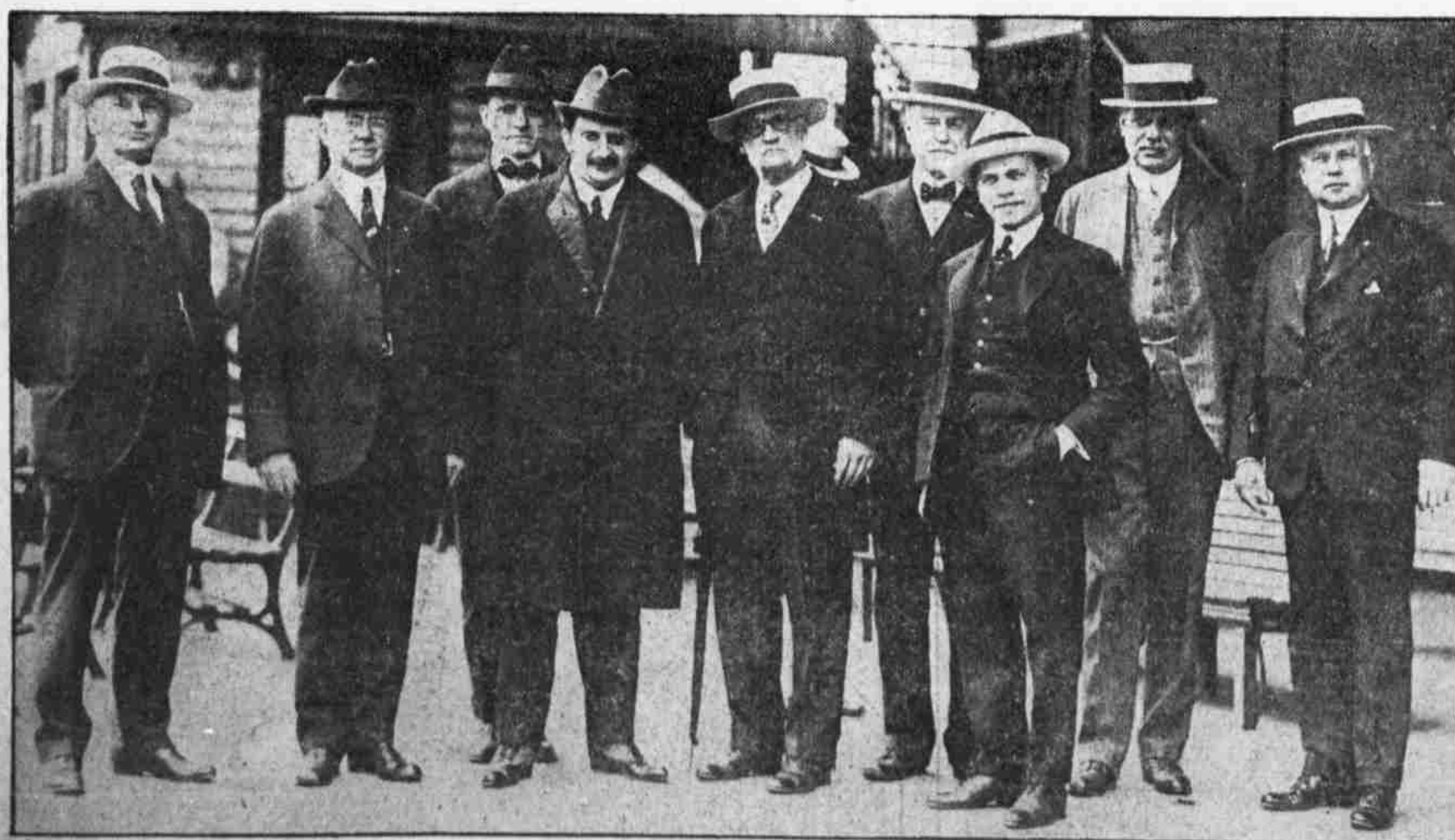
THESE ARE THE CO-ED GRADUATES OF TEMPLE UNIVERSITY

The Young Lady Across the Way

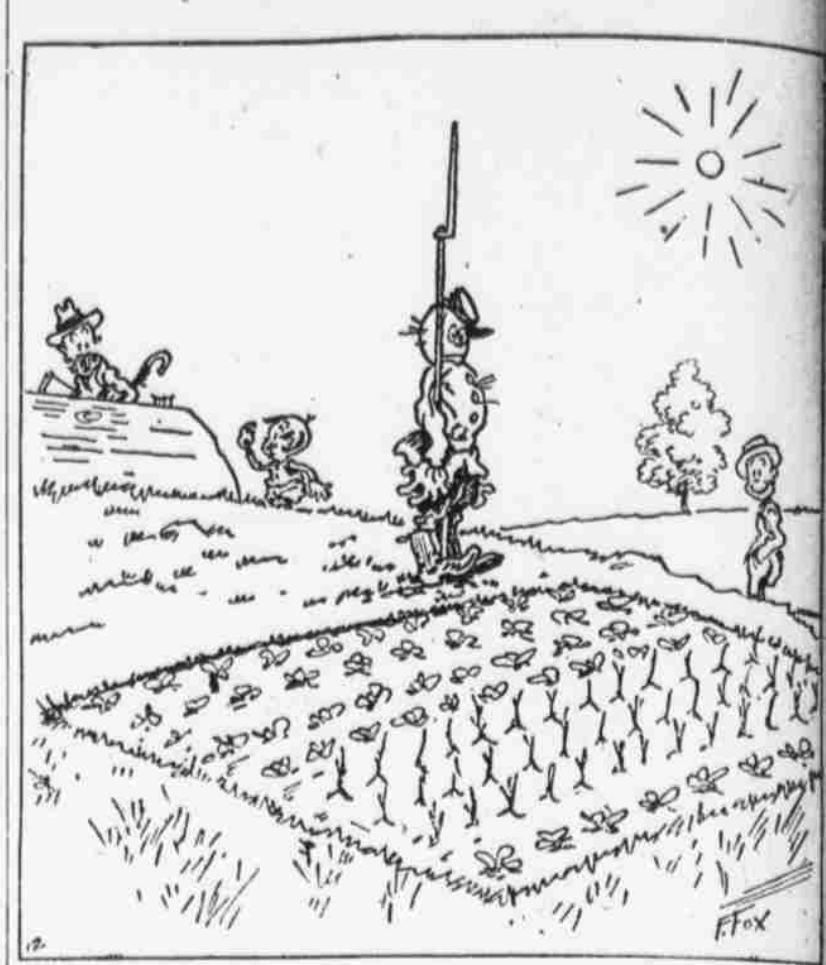

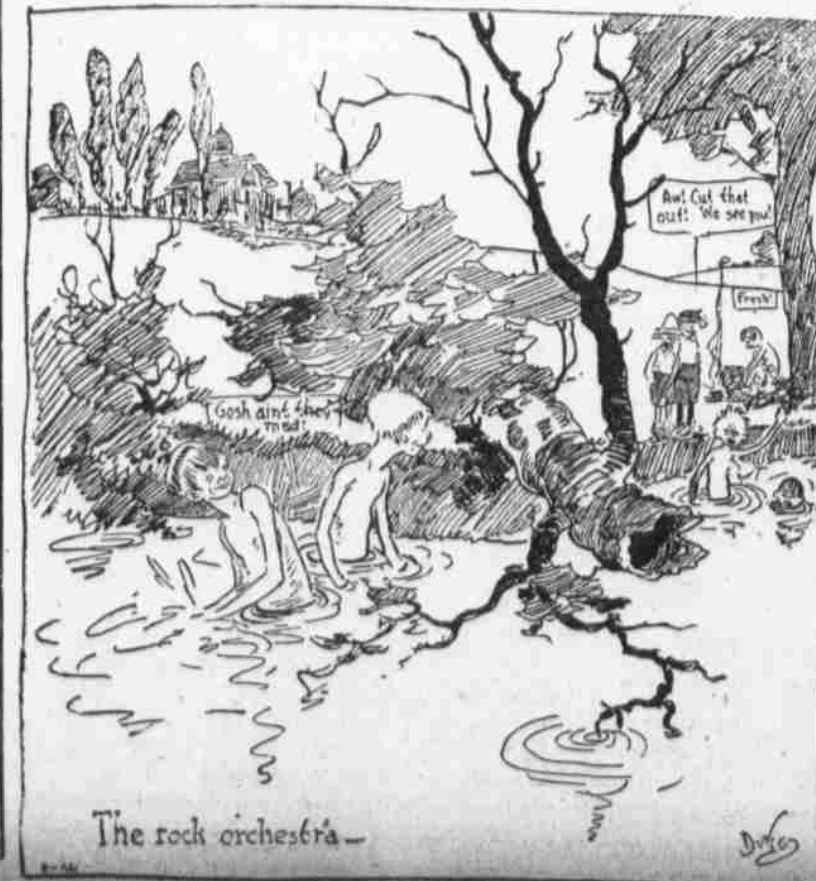
