


DEMONSTRATION BEFORE GREEK ROYAL PALACE

Venizelos, is the leader.




THEATRE OF LATEST SCENES IN GREAT HELLENIC DRAMA

whose co-operation the abdication of King Congrantine was effected.




The Young Lady Across the Way
