

LA GERMANIA STA PER PROPORRE TRATTATIVE

Il Cancelliere dell'Impero, Von Bethmann-Hollweg, Ha Accettato Una Mozione Circa la Pace

L'italia Riconoscerà la Cittadinanza Americana degli Italiani Emigrati agli Stati Uniti

Telegrammi da Londra dicono che in quel giro diplomatico non si seguono con interesse gli sviluppi della crisi in Germania, si ritiene che non è improbabile che il governo del Kaiser si prepari a fare nuove "sueverture" di pace.

Un altro deputato ungherese disse: "Non vi è politica di guerra oggi, ma soltanto politica di pace. Bisogna che il mondo politico e deve garantire le frontiere ungheresi e l'indipendenza politica dell'Ungheria."

Il presidente del Consiglio, conte Esterhazy, rispondendo a Beck, dichiarò che il governo ungherese era per la continuazione dell'alleanza con la Germania che aveva già dato prove brillanti di coerenza, ed aggiunse:

"Noi combattiamo una guerra difensiva. Non aspiriamo a conquistare e su questo punto non vogliamo lasciare alcun dubbio nei nostri nemici. Al contrario vogliamo riaffermare davanti al mondo che noi siamo pronti per la pace. I nostri nemici lo sanno e sanno che noi abbiamo fatto le proposte di pace in pieno accordo con i nostri alleati, in modo che il mondo ci trattava di una pace onerosa ed accettabile per tutti i belligeranti. Ora la responsabilità della continuazione della guerra è dei nostri nemici, non nostra."

SULLA FRONTE ITALIANA. L'era sera il Ministero della Guerra pubblicava il seguente rapporto del generale Cadorna circa la situazione alla fronte Italia-austriaca:

Si è avuta nella giornata di ieri considerabile attività nella zona di combattimento. I nostri artiglieri hanno sparato contro la fanteria nemica in marcia da Piazza a Fregazzola, nella valle del Terragnolo, ed una colonna di convogli nella valle dell'Idria.

A Speicher, in Val d'Arno, uno dei nostri ospedali da cui venivano in modo insubordinato in bandiera della Croce Rossa della invenzione di Ginevra, è ripetutamente bombardato dalle artiglierie nemiche.

Gli Italiani e gli Slavi. Washington, 14 Luglio.—Si è appreso che l'ambasciatore italiano ha raccomandato al Ministero Italiano degli Affari Esteri l'approvazione di un progetto di riconoscimento da parte del governo italiano della cittadinanza di individui di razza italiana i quali hanno emigrato agli Stati Uniti e sono naturalizzati. Si prevede che la questione che interessa tanti italiani emigrati sarà presto decisa con piena soddisfazione di ambedue i governi.
