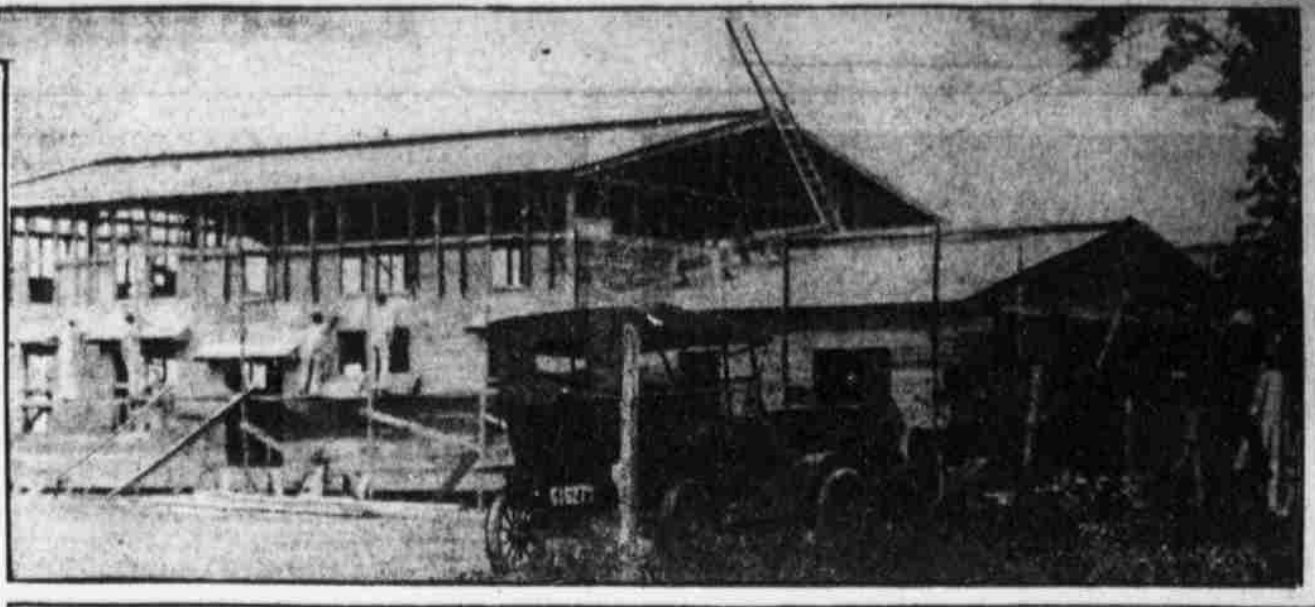




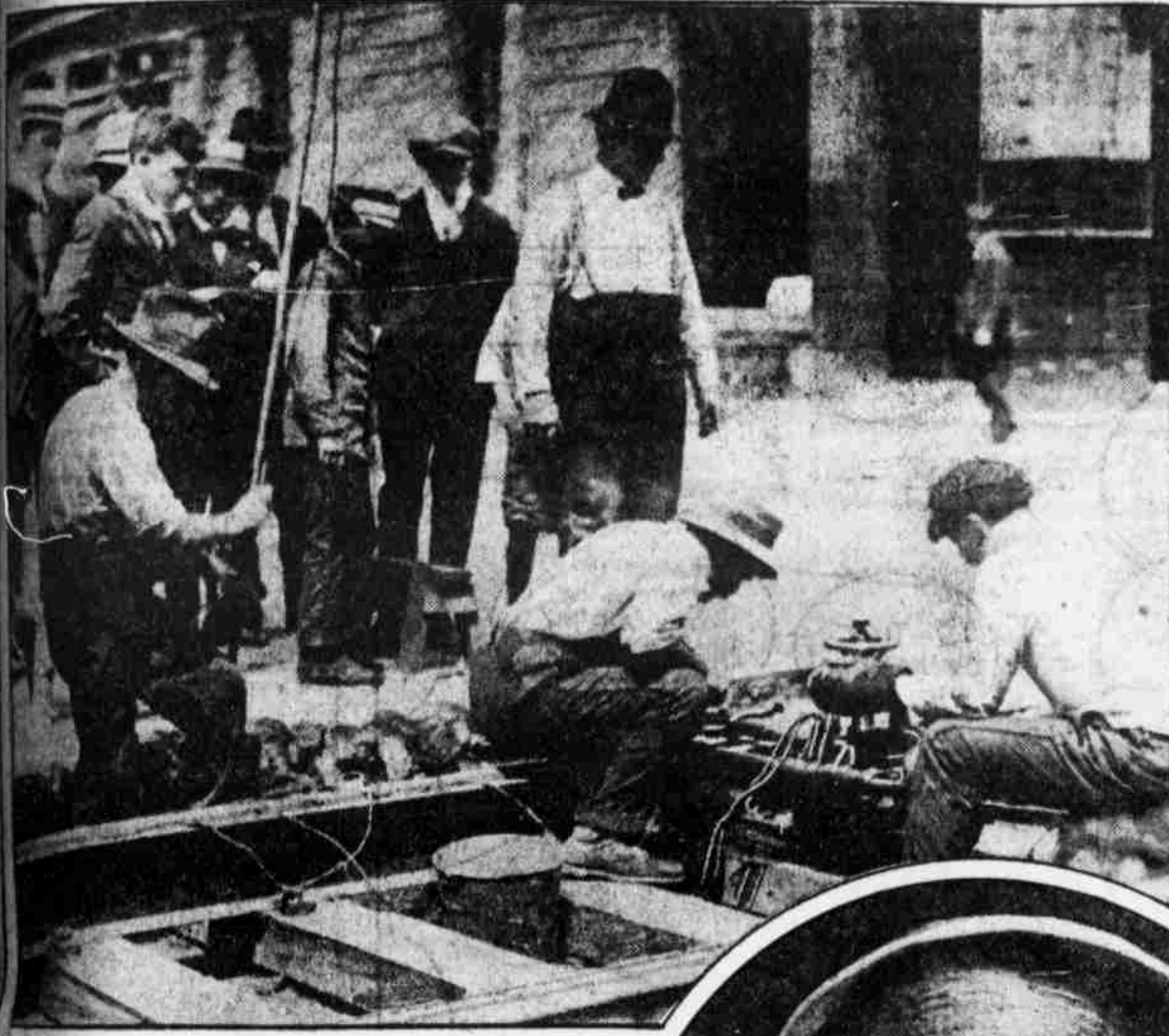
COLLEGIAN SOLDIERS FORTIFIED FOR A BUSY DAY

One of the first structures to rise in the erection of a military city is that devoted to the medical and surgical side of the garrison. Hence the speedy progress being made on the Jersey site.



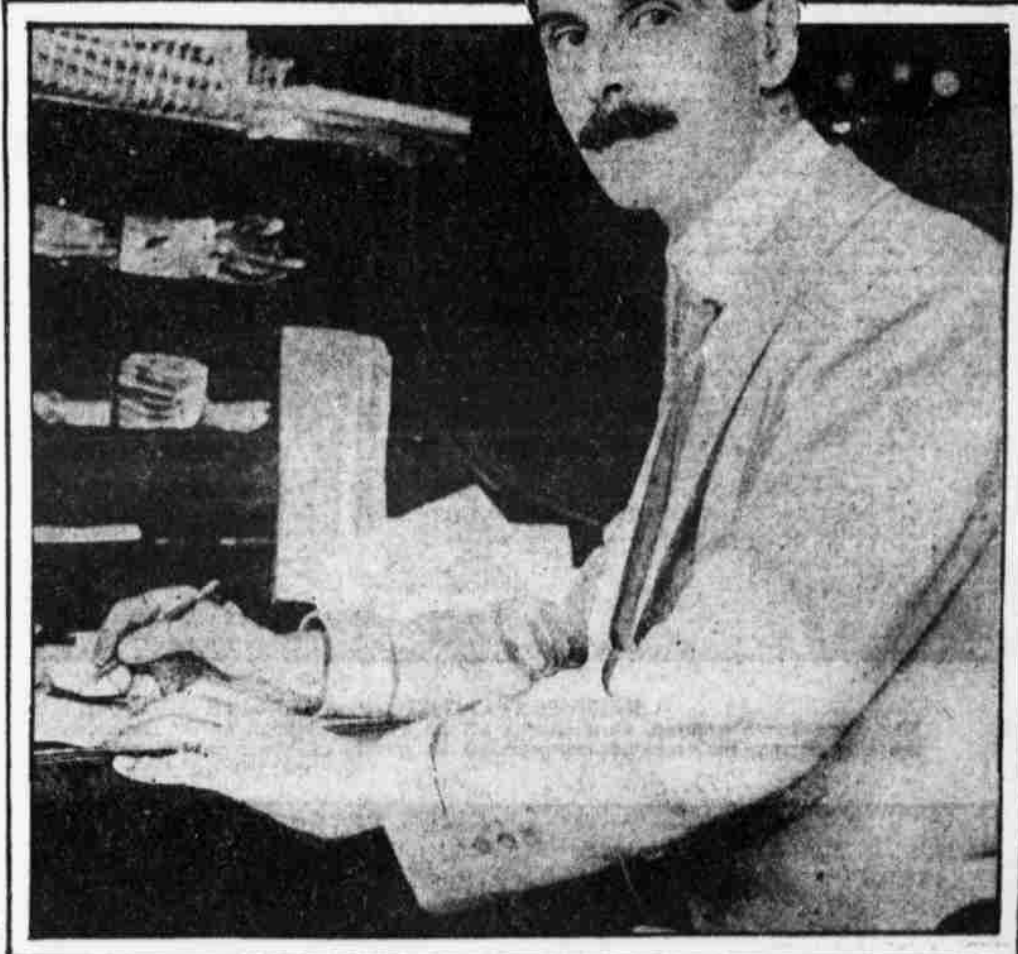
NEW RIVETING DEVICE ATTRACTS PASSERS-BY
