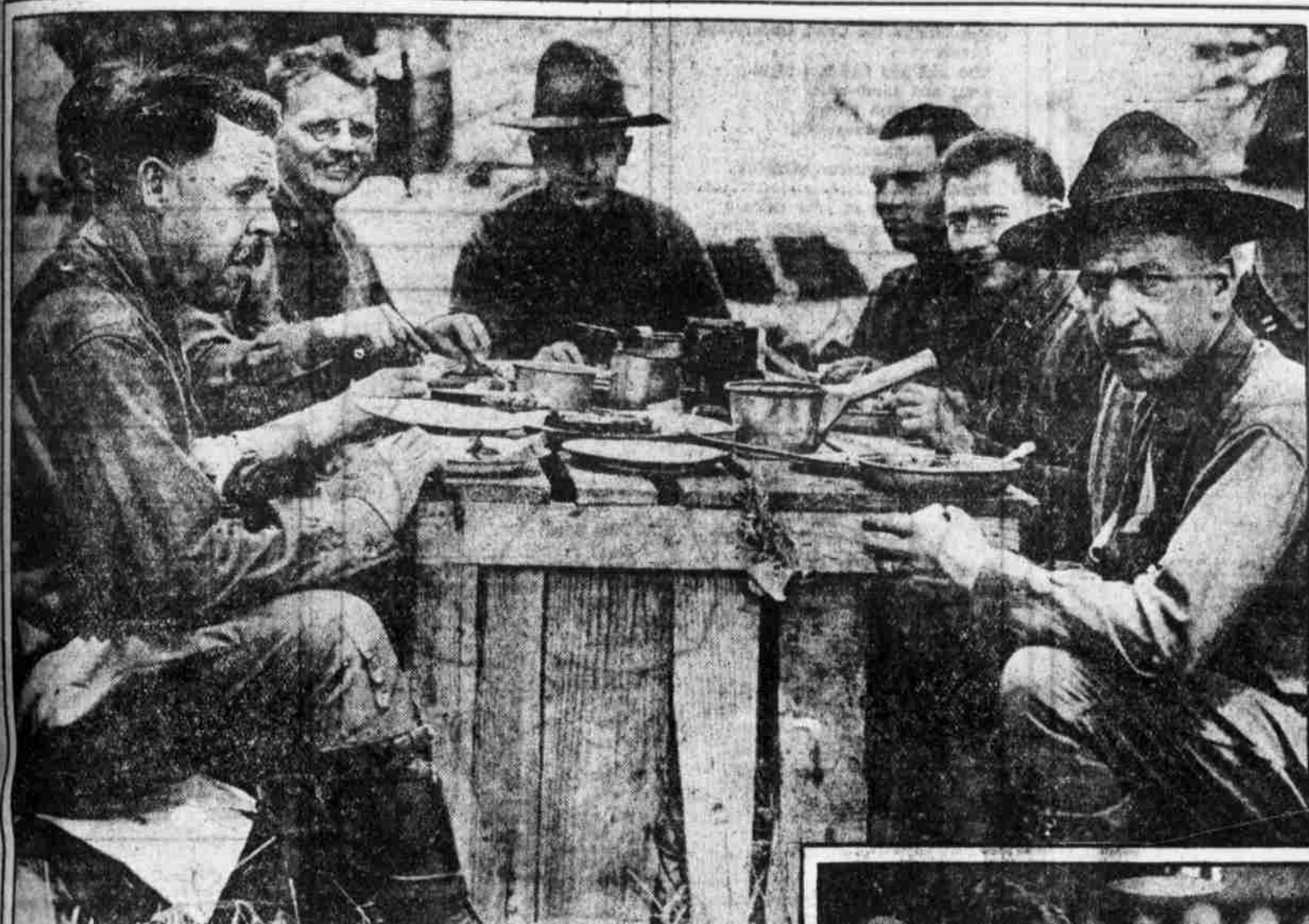


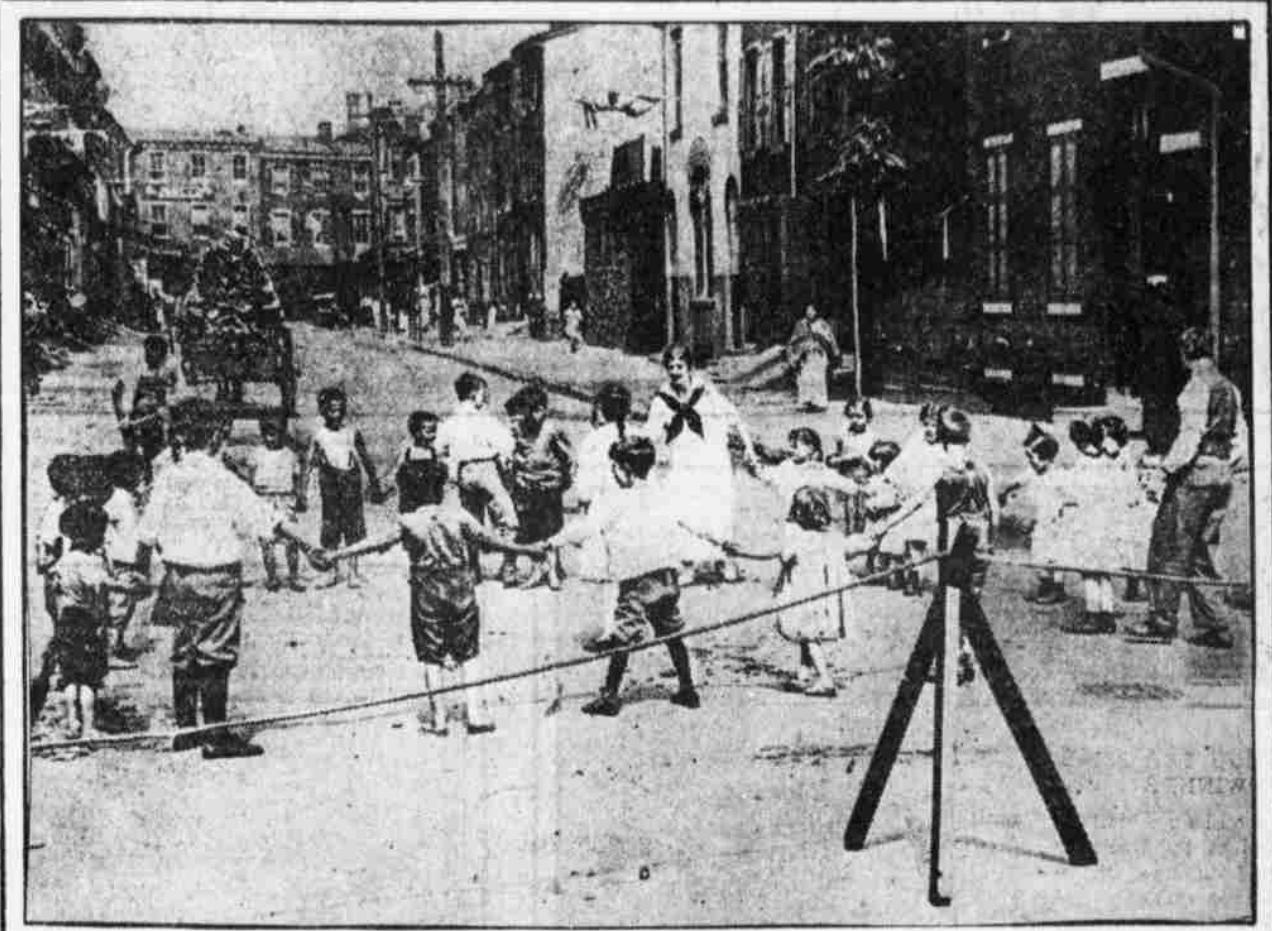
WHEREVER THERE IS NEWS WORTH PHOTOGRAPHING THE CAMERA GOES AND TAKES IT

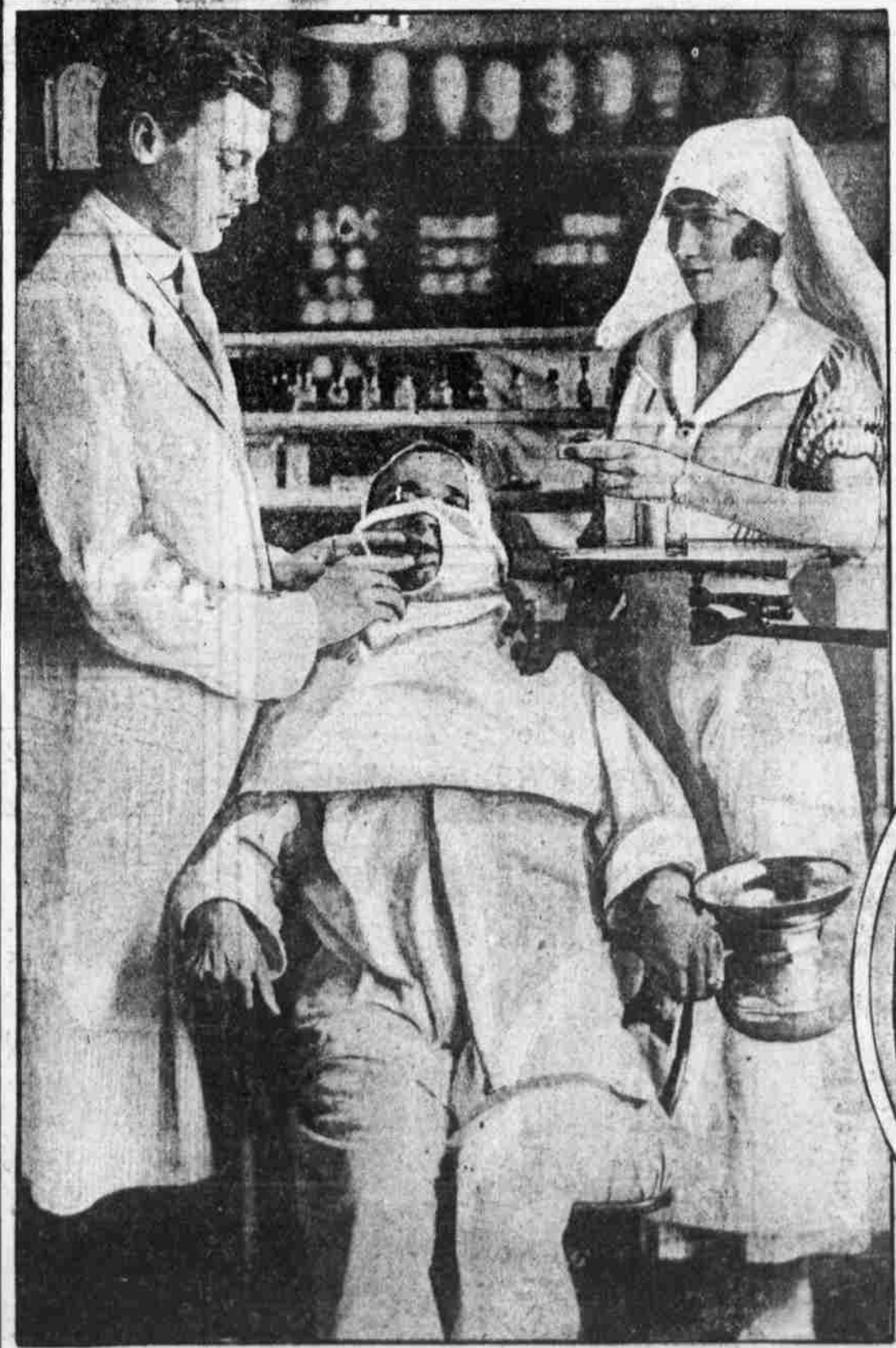
**SECOND ARTILLERY OFFICERS AT MESS TABLE**

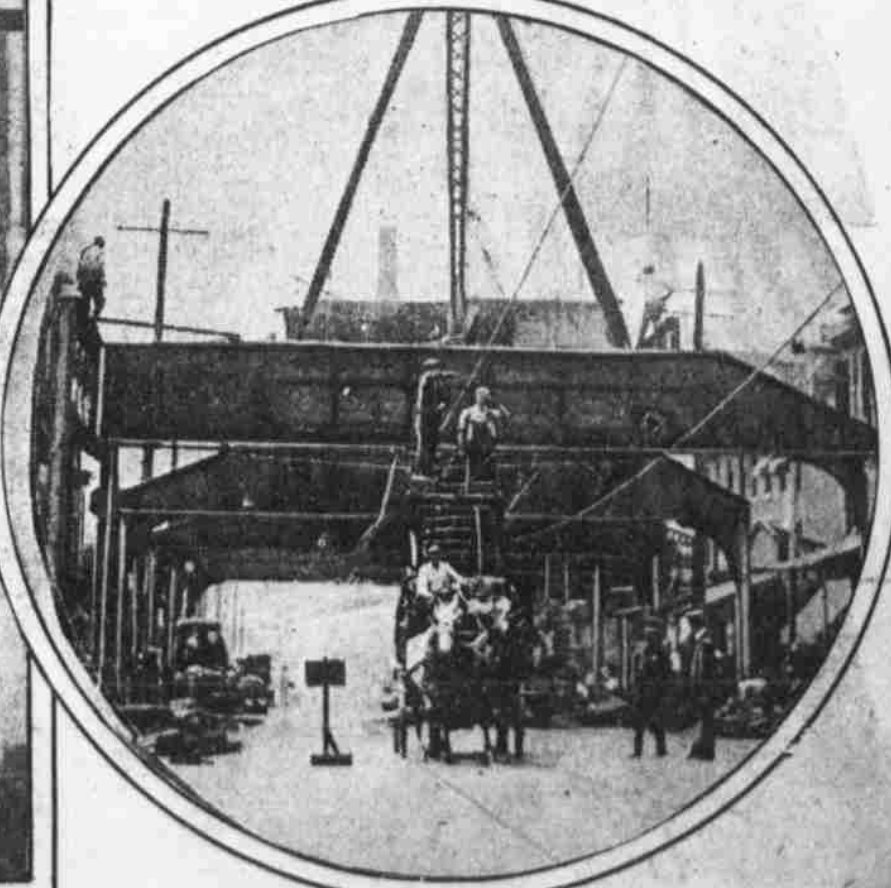
