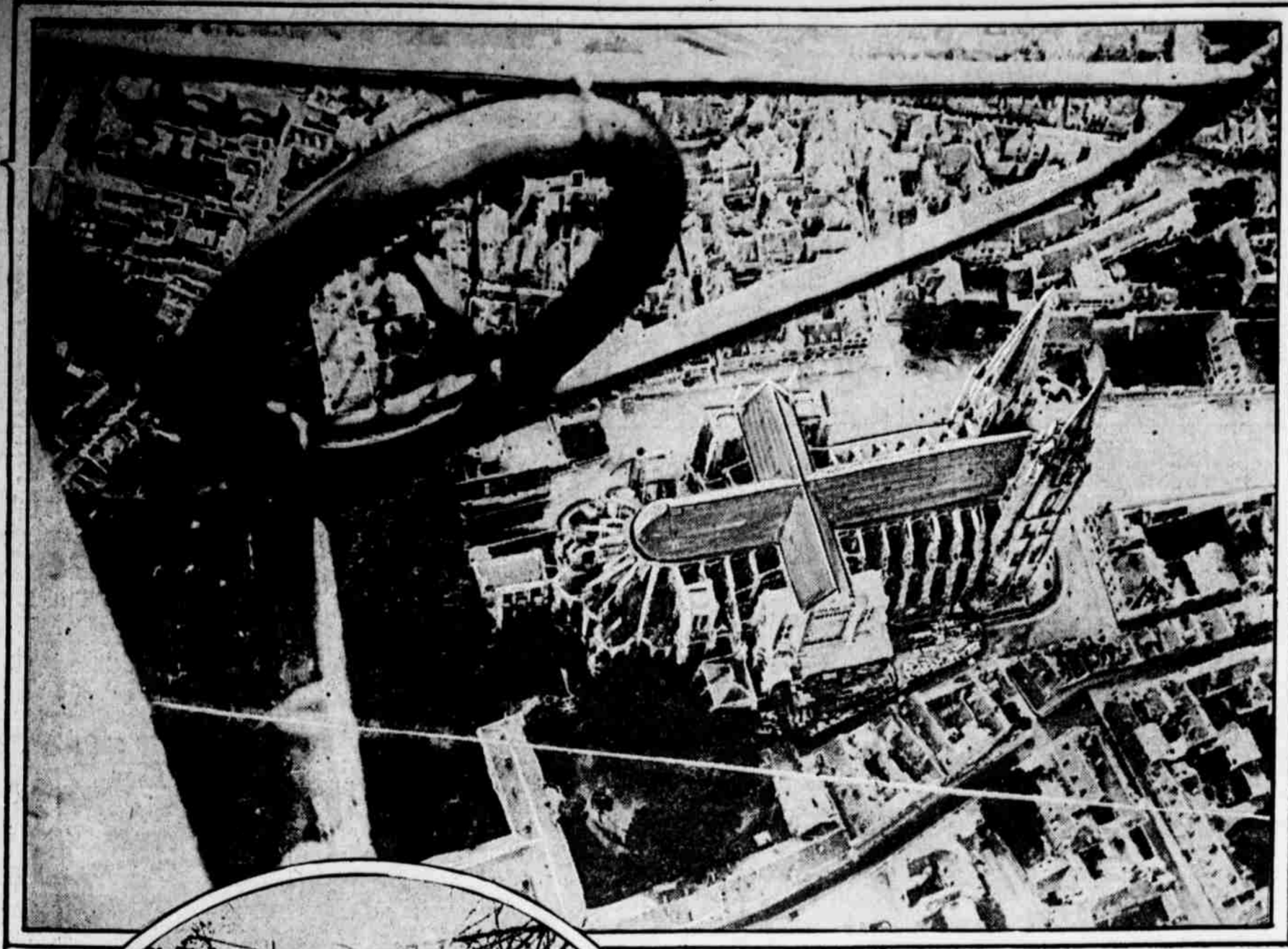


THE CAMERA RECORDS THE MARVELOUS HAPPENINGS AND SILENT SUFFERING OF THE WAR



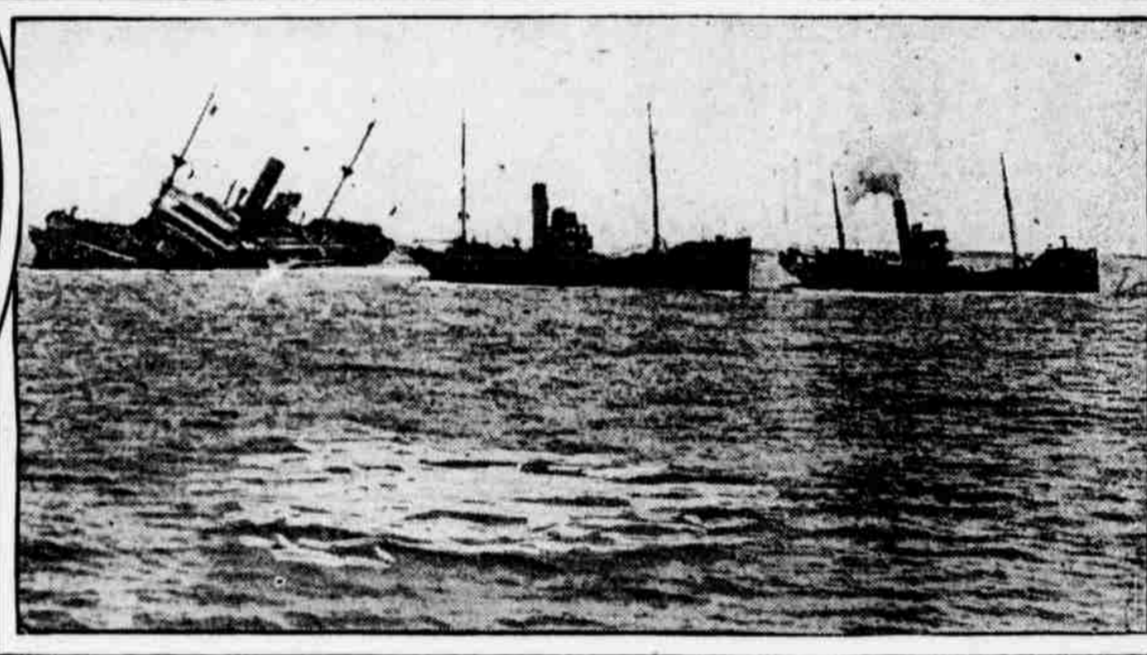

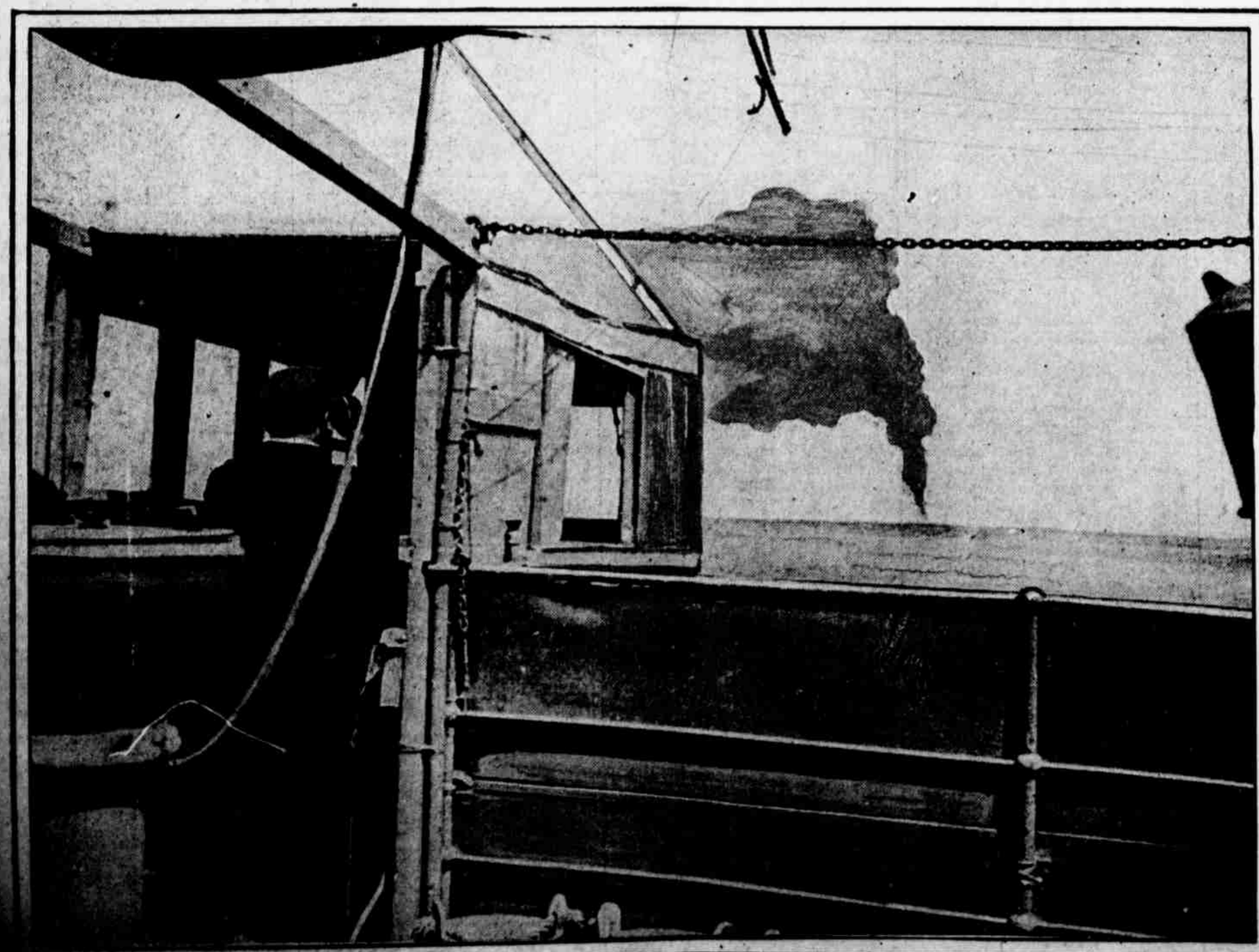
