
WAR-IMMORTALIZED GETTYSBURG NOW VIBRATES WITH THE PROSPERITY OF PEACE

From the Pennsylvania Building, of Gettysburg College, have emerged men "armed cap-a-pie" for life's intellectual battleground.




- A SHRINE OF LEARNING AND ONE OF AMERICAN PATRIOT-PILGRIMS
