

EXEMPTION PLEAS FLOODING BOARD

Claims Will Take Six Weeks to Adjust, Appeal Tri- bunal Estimates

800 IN TWENTY-FOUR HOURS

HARRISBURG, Aug. 21. Men called under the draft regulations for the National Army may serve as commissioned officers or regular army clerks, according to a ruling received here today by the State Registration and Draft Bureau from Washington. Such men will be counted in the quota to be furnished by their districts, it was said.

The bureau today reiterated its ruling that members of draft boards must consider themselves drafted for the work. Only in exceptional cases will members be excluded from duty. The district appeal boards of the State will meet here tomorrow with a representative of the Provost Marshal General's department.

A flood of exemption claims is pouring into the headquarters of Philadelphia District Appeal Board No. 2, unless the board hits upon some method by which it can speed up its work more than six weeks will elapse before the claims can be disposed of.

"In the last twenty-four hours more than 800 new claims have been received," said Monte Greenwood, chief clerk of the board. Today, when the draft officials arrived at the Federal Building, they found nearly fifty men and women waiting in line to file exemption claims.

A majority of the men who appeared this morning have been denied exemptions by their local boards and in a final effort to escape military service have carried their cases to the appeal board.

The appeal board accepted the affidavits of these men, but declined to hear oral arguments that many of the men wished to make.

Complying with the request of the War Department, the board tackled a batch of claims that involve highly trained men in munitions plants and other industrial establishments engaged in war work.

INDUSTRIAL CLAIMS

More than 1000 industrial claims for exemption have been made in Philadelphia, according to Walter Willard, chairman of the District Appeal Board No. 2 which organized yesterday and held its first sitting in the United States District Court.

Both district appeal boards in this city are to settle on a definite line of action so that the same policy will be followed by both in dealing with all cases, Mr. Willard said. Every effort will be made to see that one board does not exempt a man for reasons that the other would consider invalid. The same treatment will be accorded to all, it was explained.

Tomorrow members of the board will confer with Adjutant General Stewart in Harrisburg relative to the manner in which many exemption cases are to be handled.

Men Accepted for New Army

Physical examinations of men for the National Army are being rushed with all possible speed by local boards. Action on exemption claims is progressing more slowly. The following reports cover the city:

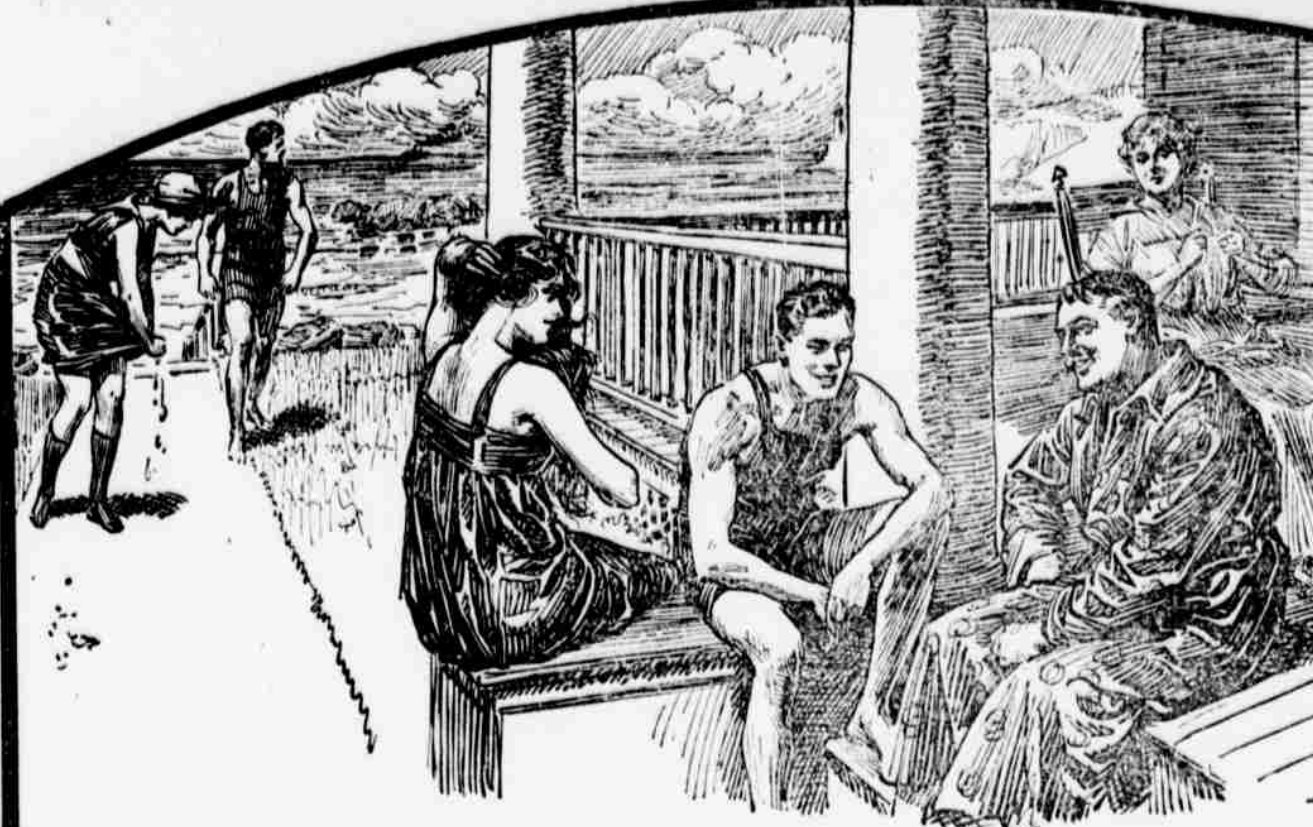

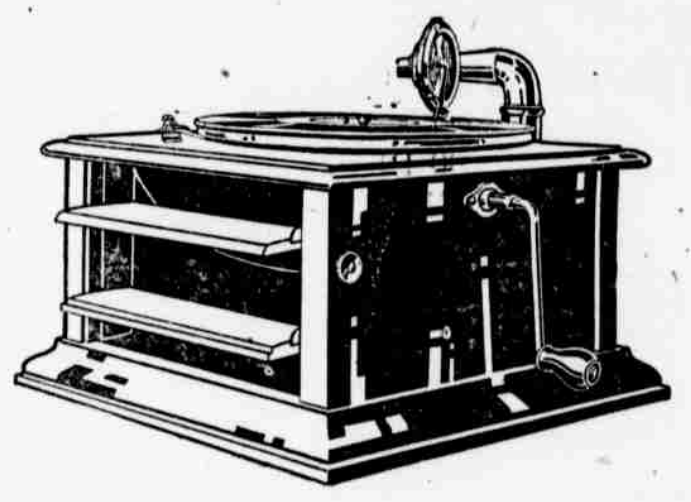
