Every Child Should Be Taught to Remember

NEVER to steal rides by hanging on the back of wagons, trucks, automobiles or street cars. You are liable to jump or fall off directly in front of a trolley or automobile. Hundreds of boys are killed or injured every year in this way.

NEVER to cross a street without first stopping and looking both

NEVER attempt to run or dodge if caught in the middle of the street with vehicles coming in both directions. Stand still and the drivers probably will be able to go around you safely. NEVER to ride a bicycle too close to a street car or automobile, or catch hold of either of them for the sake of a tow.

NEVER ride a bicycle on the left side of the street. Keep to the right and never try to dodge in front of a trolley or auto and you are comparatively safe.

NEVER play ball or tag in a street frequented by automobiles.

NEVER jump on or off a moving elevator, trolley or train. It is better to be a few minutes late than go through life a cripple.
