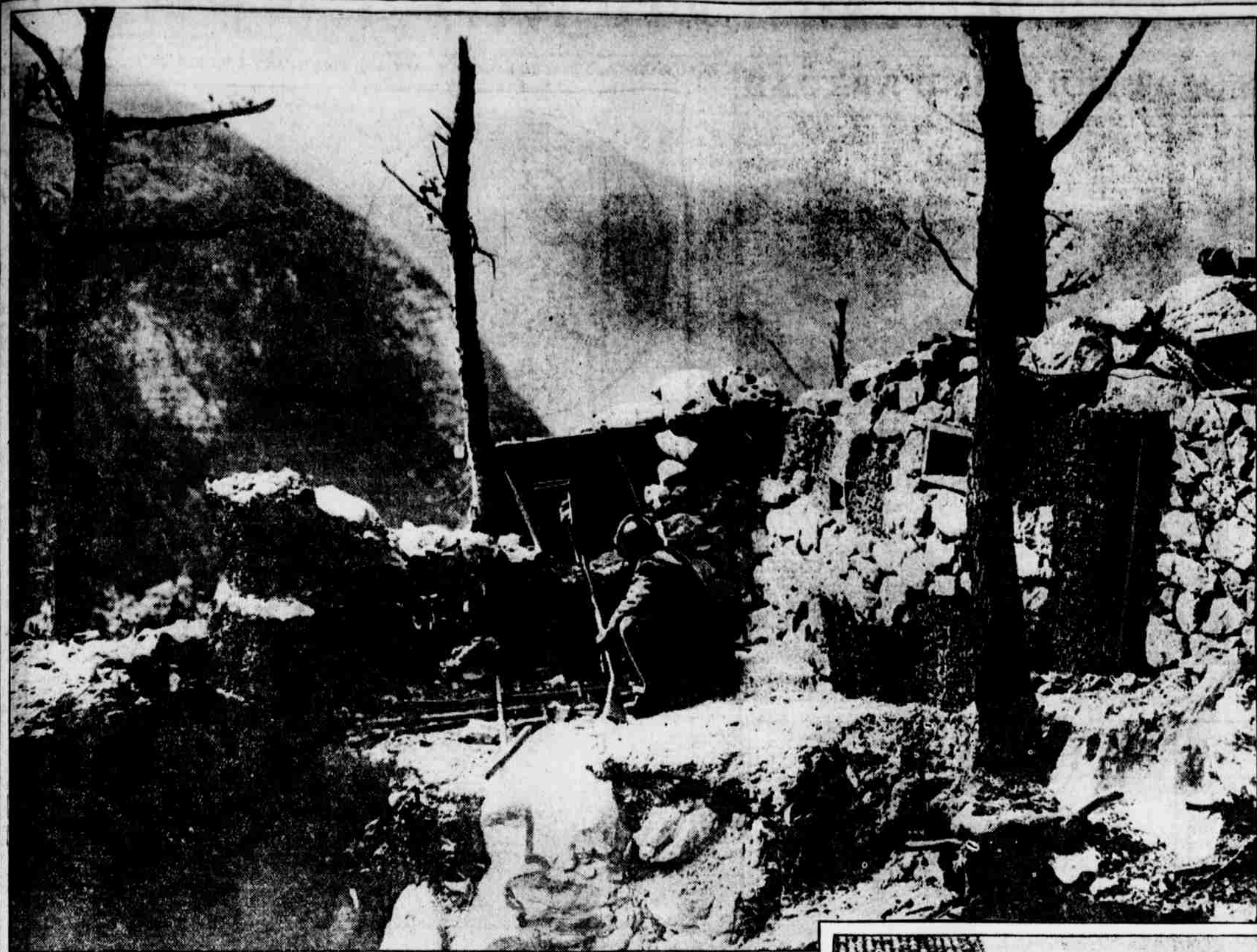
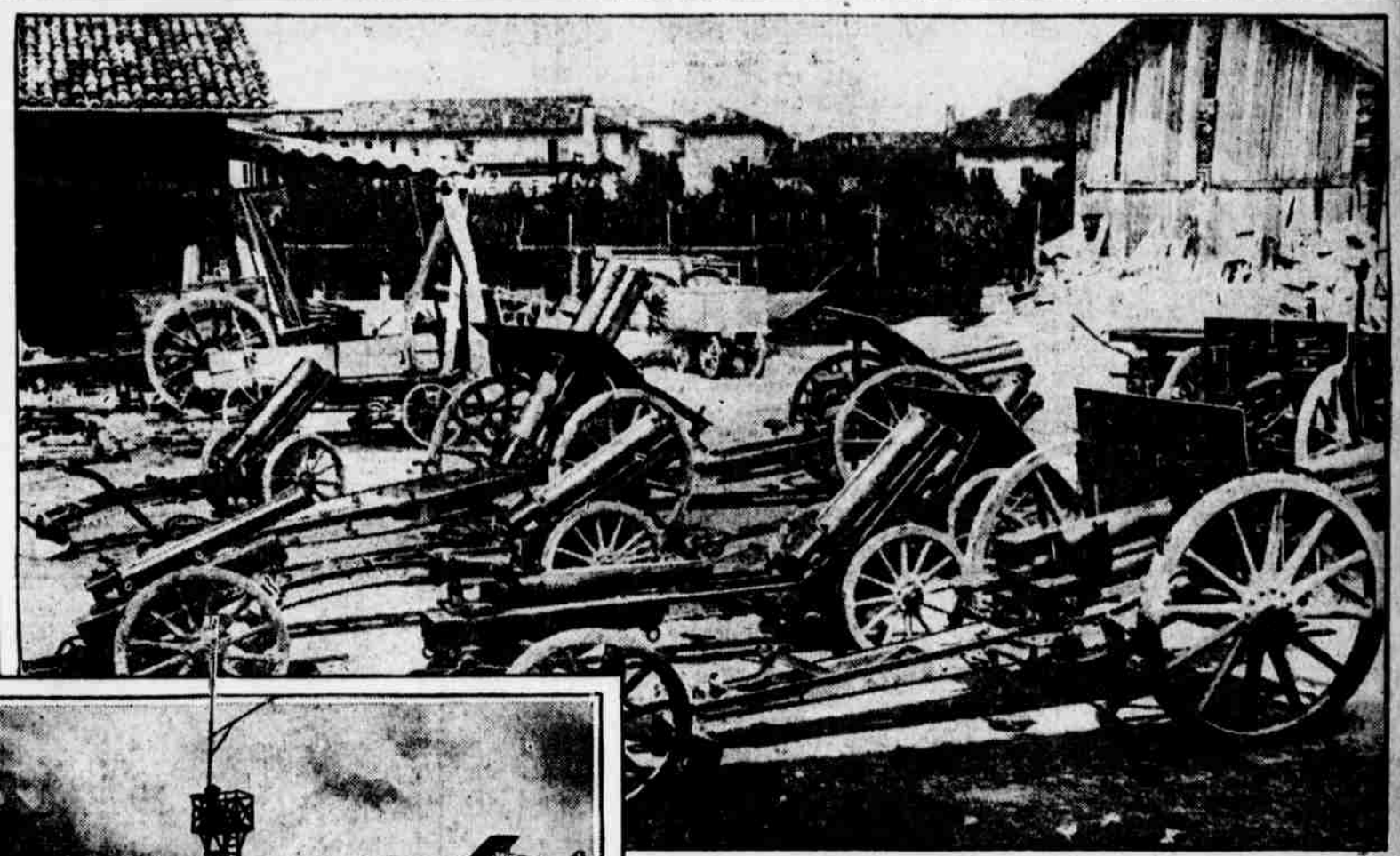

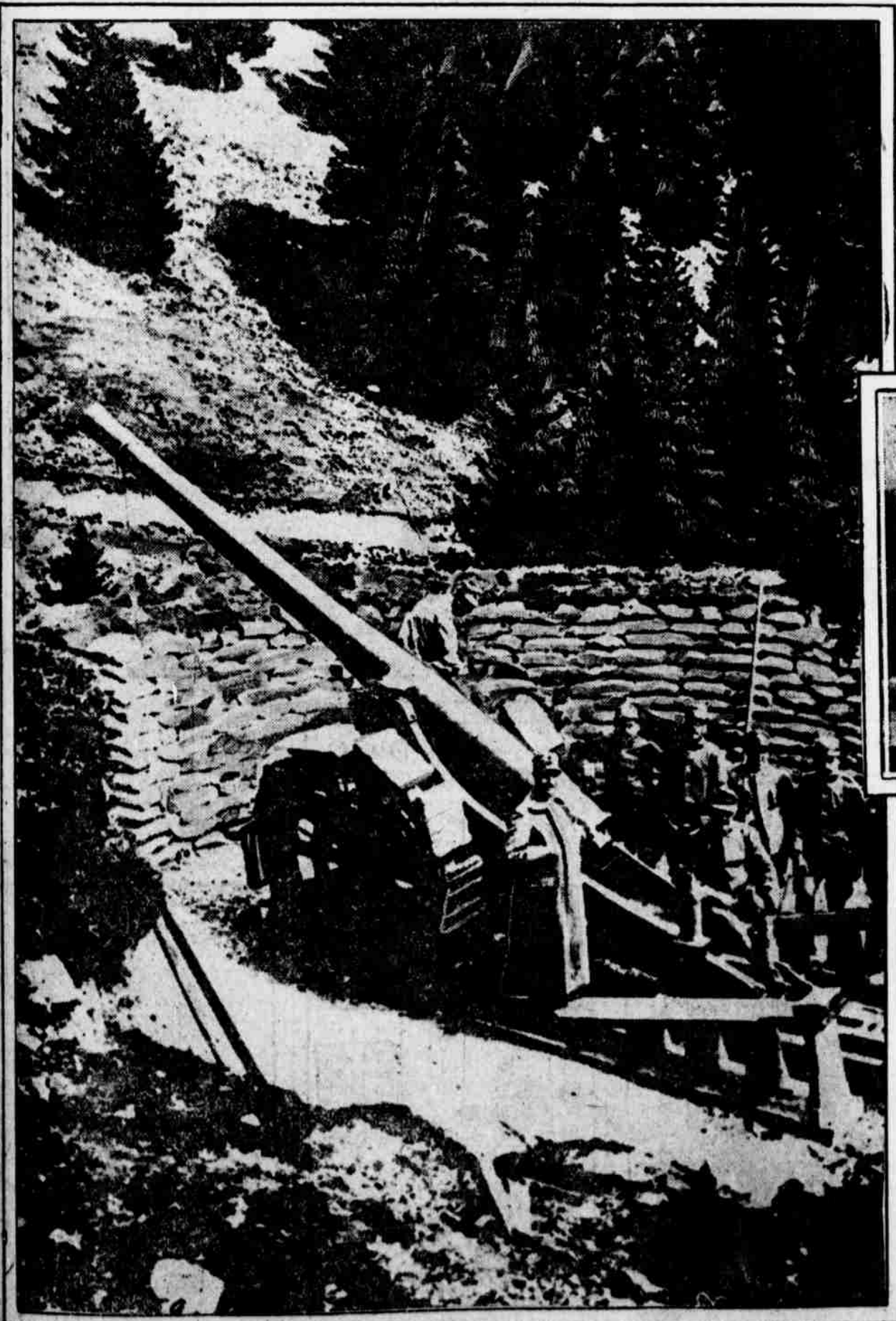


THE DUKE OF AOSTA, CAPTOR OF GORIZIA
