Eventi eccezionali maturano in Argentina. La Camera del Congresso ha approvato la vittoria da essi riportata ha grande importanza non solo per il numero dei prigionieri catturati e per le perdite inflitte al nemico.

Il pomeriggio si e' riunito il gabinetto e si apprende che il governo e' preparato a prendere gravi ed eccezionali misure in vista dei nuovi eventi.

Anche la Cina e' pronta a dare un valido aiuto agli alleati. Ieri il presidente e' il gabinetto sono venuti alla determinazione di inviare, come prova, una divisione di 10,000 uomini in Francia.
