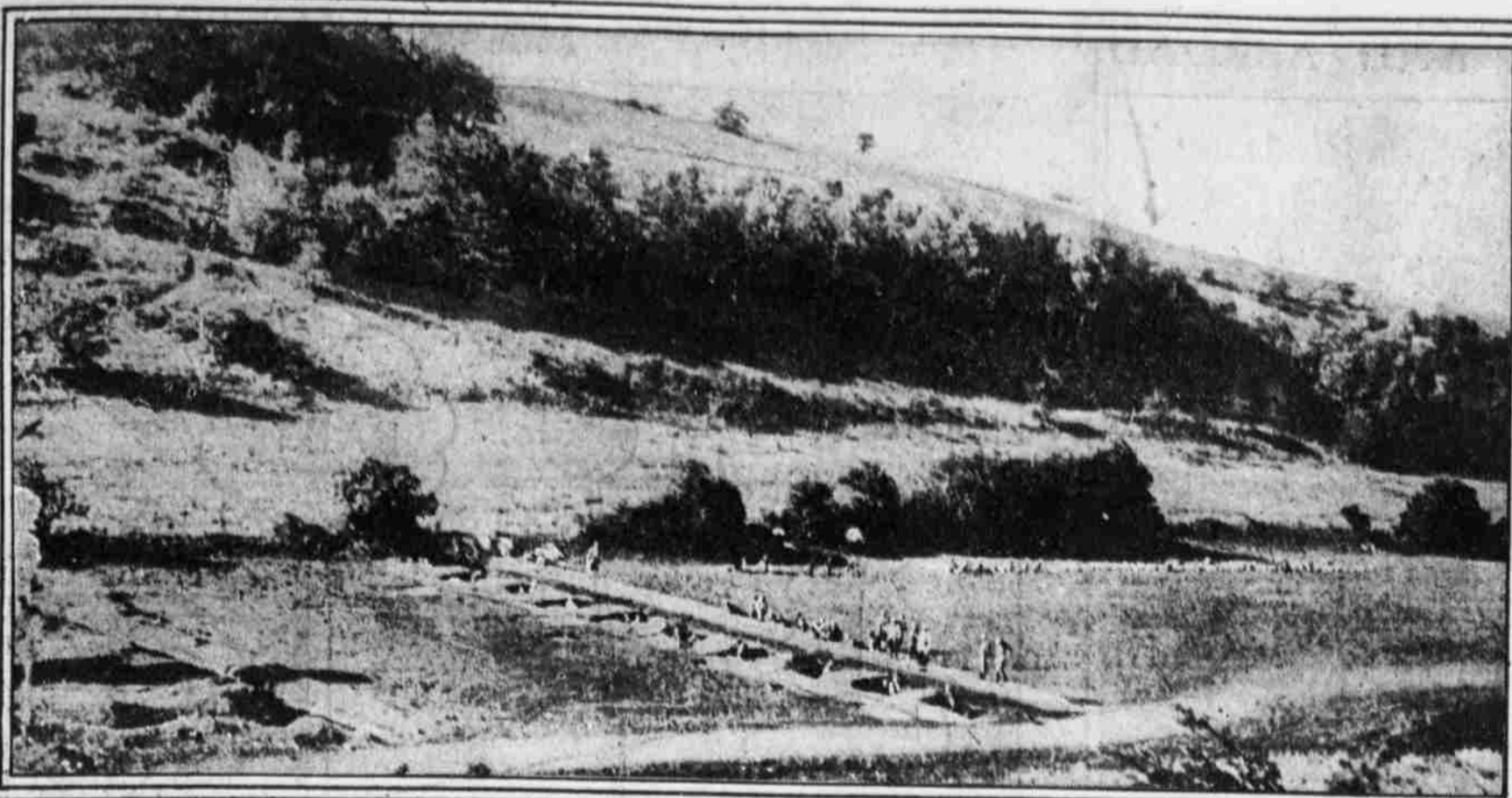
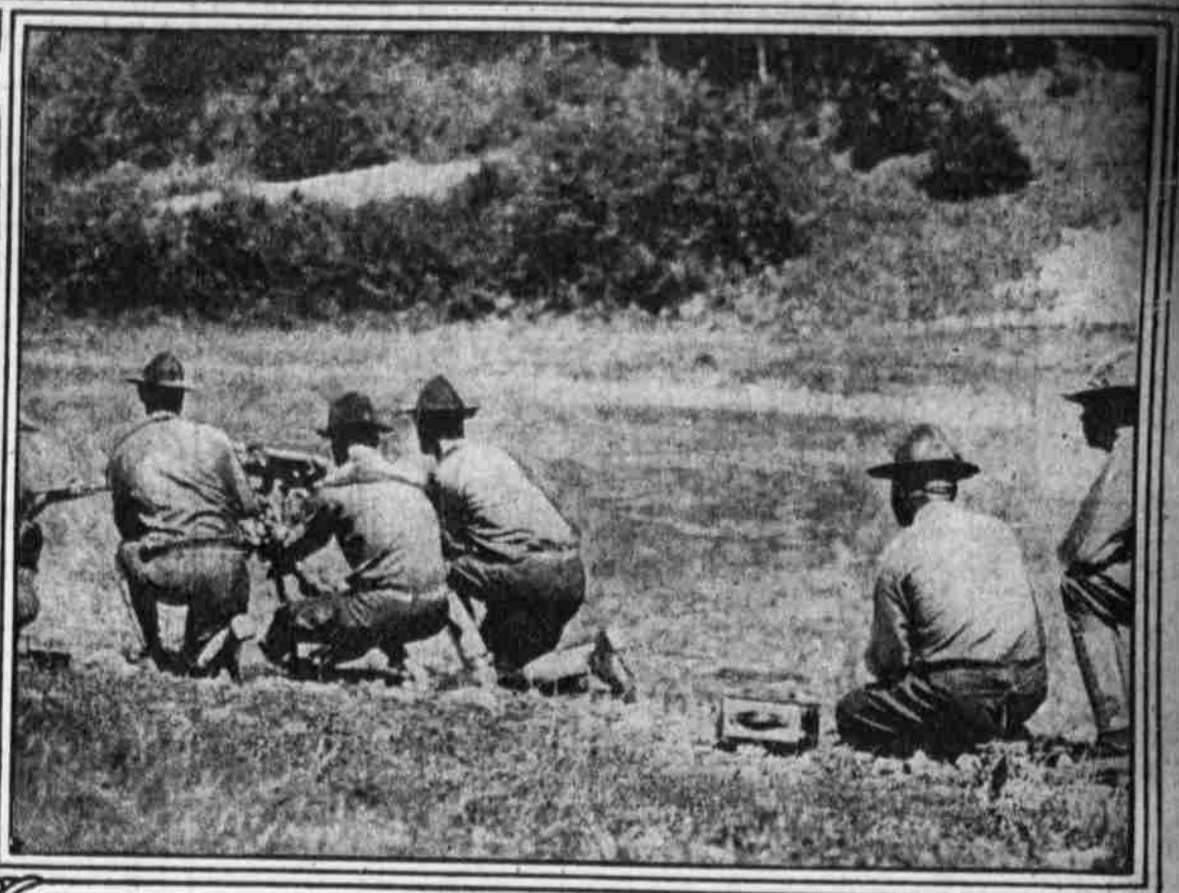

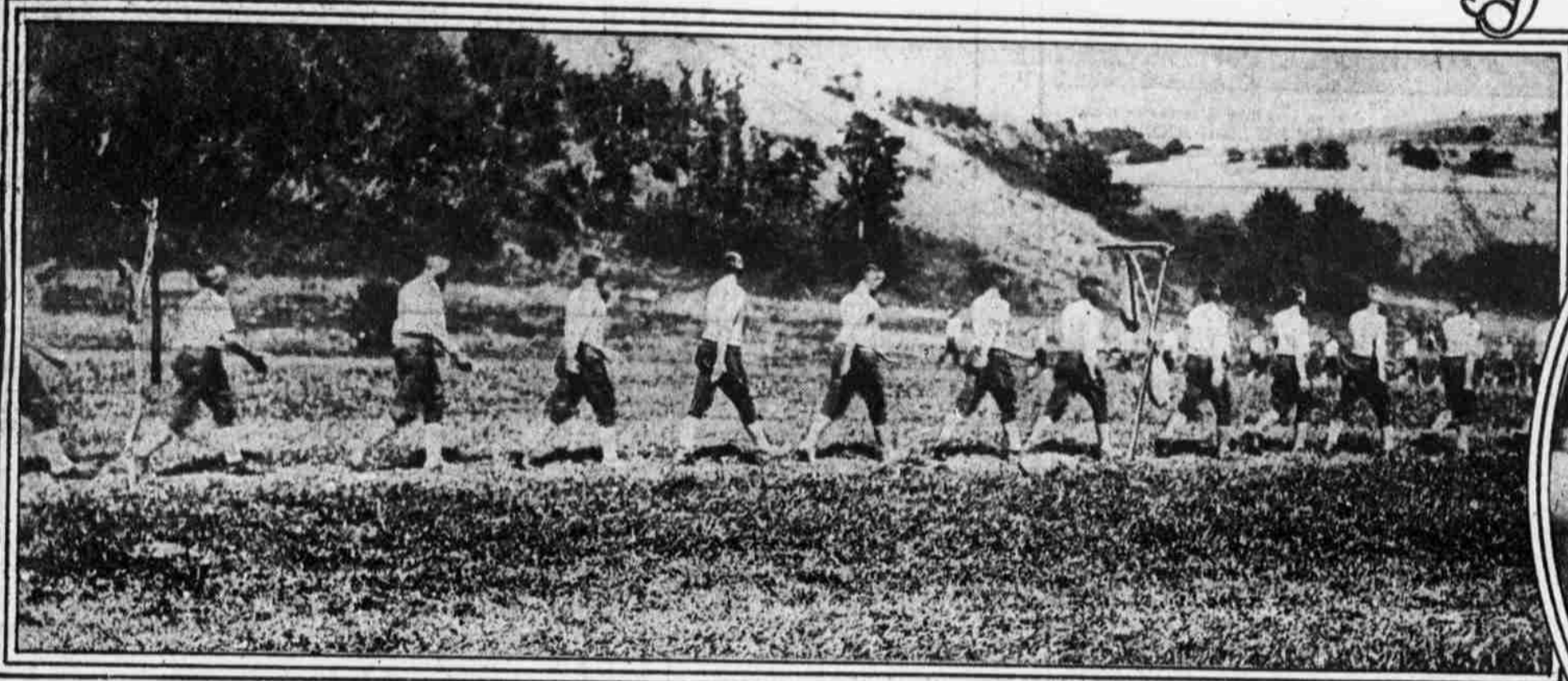

SAMMEE MITRAILLEUSE SQUAD AT PRACTICE IN KNEELING POSTURE



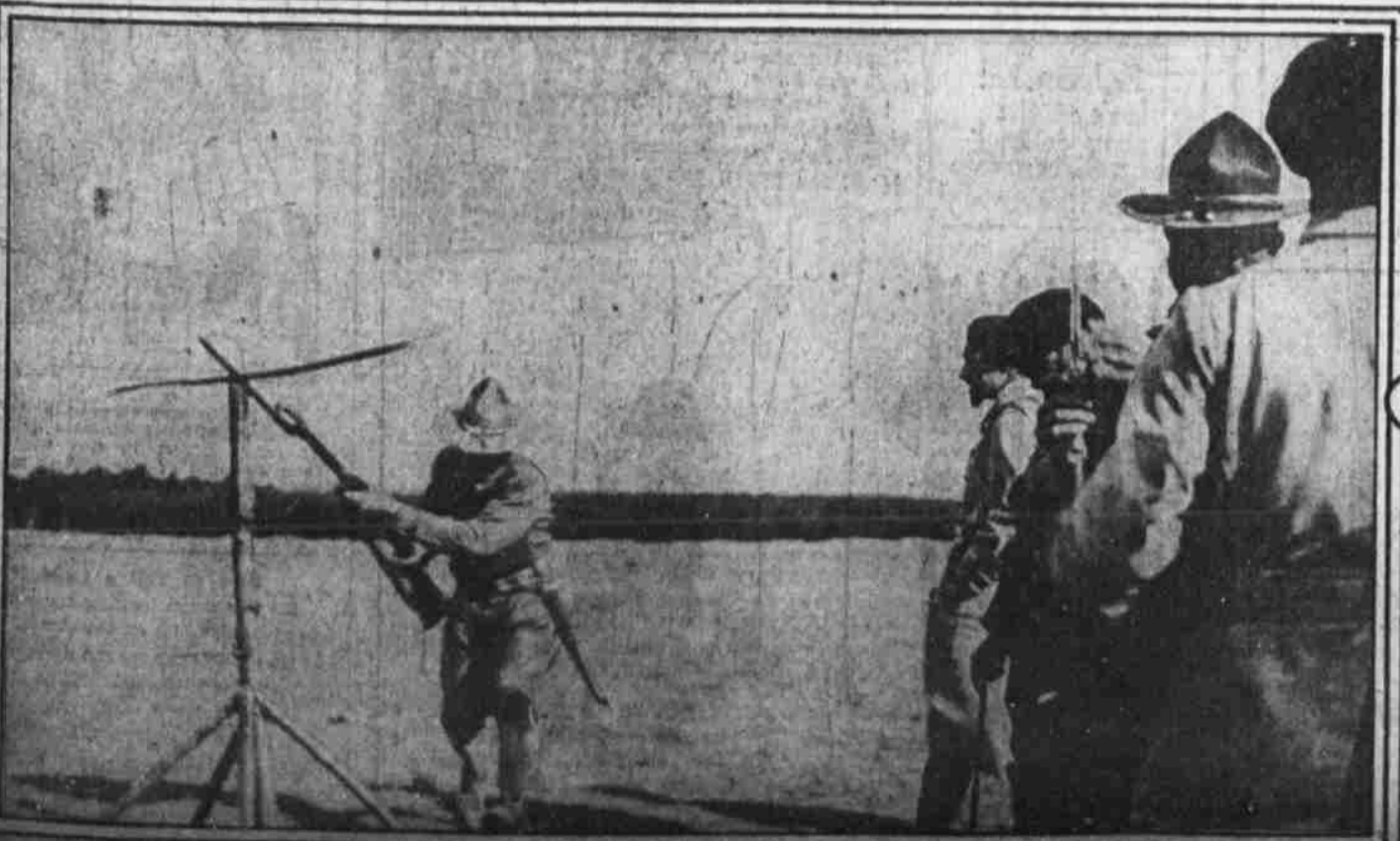
