OUTS FOR BIGGER PAY

Joseph E. Ralph, Director of U. S. Engraving Bureau, Accepts New Job

WASHINGTON, Oct. 5.-Joseph E. Ralph, for ten years director of the Bureau of Engraving and Printing, has tendered his resignation to become president of the United States Engraving and Printing Company, a new banknote corporation. It is supposed that Mr. Ralph will be succeeded as director by Frank E. Ferguson, now assistant director, who has held that office during the entire incumbency of Mr. Ralph.

During his service as director Mr. Ralph has brought the Bureau of Engraving and Printing to a high state of efficiency. The work of printing money, bonds and postage stamps has increased tremendously in recent years, but Mr. Ralph has met the additional tasks imposed upon him with a degree of energy and initiative that has frequently brought flattering comment from the high officials of the Treasury Department.

An director Mr. Ralph received a salary of \$50,000. His salary as president of the new corporation will be \$10,000, and in addition, he will have large stock holdings. Mr. Ralph is a Pennsylvania.

WANTS TOLL ROADS FREED

Lieutenant Governor McClain Upholds His Position on Highways

LANCASTER, Pa., Oct. 5.-In a letter written by Lieutenant Governor McClain to C. A. R. Zook, president of the Free Highway Association, Lancaster County, Pa., the lieutenant governor has expressed his opposition to the proposed toll roads, which he says belong to a period so far back that it seems it would have been in the morning of the world.

Speaking in the State column of the Lincoln Highway, he points out that in the entire 2000 miles of that highway the only section upon which toll is charged is in Lancaster County, between Williamsport and Columbia, twenty-three miles in York County, from Wrightsville to York and beyond a few miles, and another short stretch in Adams County.
