

BALTIMORE GUNNER CRACK TARGET SHOT

Lester German, Former Ball Player, Averages 95 Per Cent at Traps

That much-noticed question that is heard at sporting writers time and again, "What becomes of the ball players of pasable days, is again with us. Ordinarily, they retire to the everyday simple life or working in some commercial field other than the national pastime.

Lester German, former New York Giant pitcher, is one ball player who has blazed a trail in his profession, following a job of years on the diamond.

German has made his home in Baltimore, The Oriole wing shot has averaged 95 per cent for his shooting for several years, which easily ranks him among the foremost gunners of the age.

German has traveled around the eastern States year in and year out, shooting at 7000 to 10,000 clay birds per annum under all sorts of conditions, and his record of smashing all but 5 per cent of them is clearly demonstrative of his marksmanship ability.

The Maryland wing shot hit his target in the Maryland State title match at Baltimore, which was nicknamed "Long Run" German. The most startling performance of Lester was at Atlantic City in the big West Virginia annual annual, which he won without a miss. This feat alone proved his mastery skill with the scatter shot weapon.

For the program of 6500 targets at that tournament, German's steady aim was responsible for the scoring of 617 of that quota.

Maryland is proud of German, for he has added much to that State's prestige by winning honors all over the country.

In 1917 the former national pastime has done remarkable work at the traps. He had 11 runs of fifty targets straight. Nineteen were 100 per cent breaks of 100, while Lester's high mark was 130 breaks at Baltimore on June 7.

If four men were picked to represent the United States in an international match with England, France or Italy, it is almost a positive fact that Lester German would be one of the first named on the list for the Statesmen.
