

STOCKS SCORE GOOD GAINS IN EARLY NEW YORK TRADING

Marine-Preferred Attracts Much Attention and Steel Common Advances More Than a Point—Railroads Higher

Advances in stock prices were in order at the beginning of business, with the demand sustained during the first fifteen minutes when gains ranging from 1 to 2 points were made in many issues.

United States Steel common moved up more than 1 point to 91 1/2, and Crucible continued its advance, selling at 56 1/2 against 55 1/2 at the close yesterday.

There was a special movement in Mexican Petroleum, reflecting a renewal of the accumulation, on which its price rose 2 1/2 to 85 1/2.

American Smelting made a gain of 1 point to 29, Union Pacific rose 1 point to 112 and Reading 1 1/2 to 71 1/2.
