STOCK BROKERS WORK UNDER DIFFICULTIES IN NEW YORK

Prices Start Generally Higher in Cold, Dark Exchange, but Business Is Small, and Irregularity Comes Soon After Opening

NEW YORK, Jan. 21.—The Stock Exchange was almost dark at the opening today, and while the members were overcast, sweaters and hats were on the floor registered more than sixty degrees.

The market position was not influenced by the contraction of trade facilities in accordance with the order of the fuel administrator.

The two stocks directly concerned in Mexican affairs were the most prominent features, American Smelting advancing 1 1/2 to 8 3/4, and there was continued accumulation of Mexican Petroleum, which rose 1 1/2 to 9 1/2.

Later there was a tendency to irregularity, with business very small. The cashiers' section of the association of Stock Exchange firms has issued the following request: "On account of the limited elevator service being rendered by various buildings in the Wall street district it is requested that all cashiers make deliveries as early as possible, and have all checks ready to be issued for securities delivered as soon as they are received, thus limiting the number of times messengers would have to call at the same offices."

CHANGES IN CORN PRICES ARE SLIGHT

Expectations of Larger Receipts Incline Trade to Await Further Developments

CHICAGO, Jan. 21.—Expectations of larger receipts caused an easier feeling in the corn market this morning. Changes in prices, however, were slight, and the market inclined to await further developments on the movement. The arrivals here today were 163 cars.

January opened 1/2 cent lower at 75 1/2. March started at a decline of 3/4, at 75 3/4. May was quoted at 76 1/4 to 76 3/4 at the outset and sold at 76 1/4.

The receipts of wheat at Minneapolis and Duluth today were 294 cars, against 197 last year; at Winnipeg, 215 cars, against 181 last year; at Chicago, 2 cars, against 32 cars.
