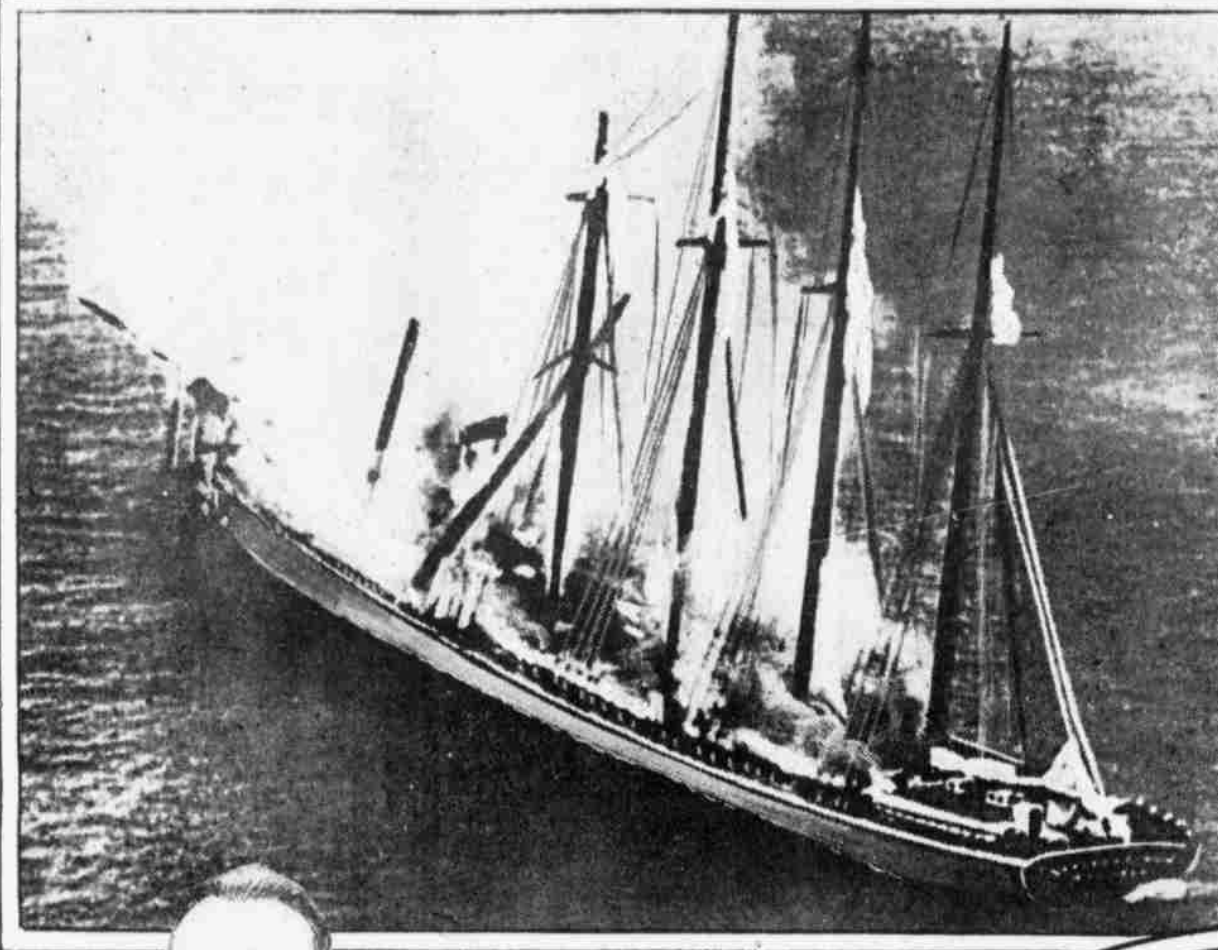

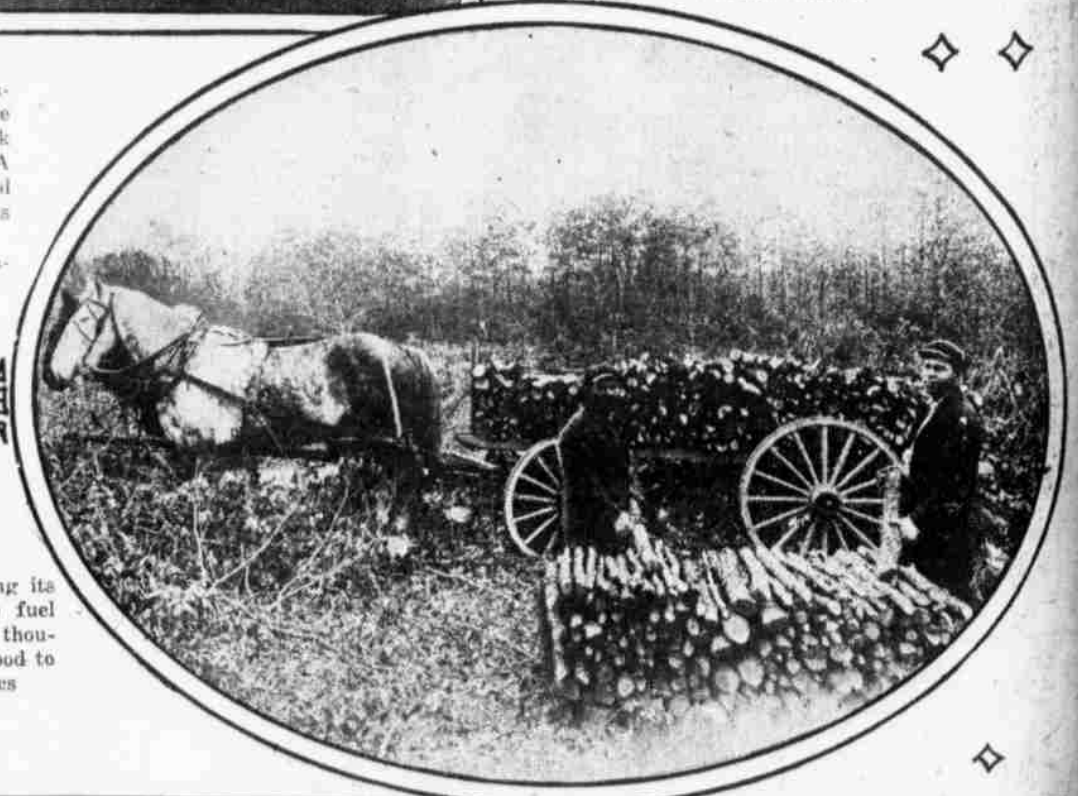
First official photograph to reach this country showing the orderly retreat of the Third Italian army after yielding before the concentrated assault of the Austro-Germans.

The human race is all at war And thinks of fighting night and day. I surely feel embarrassed now To have God see us act this way.

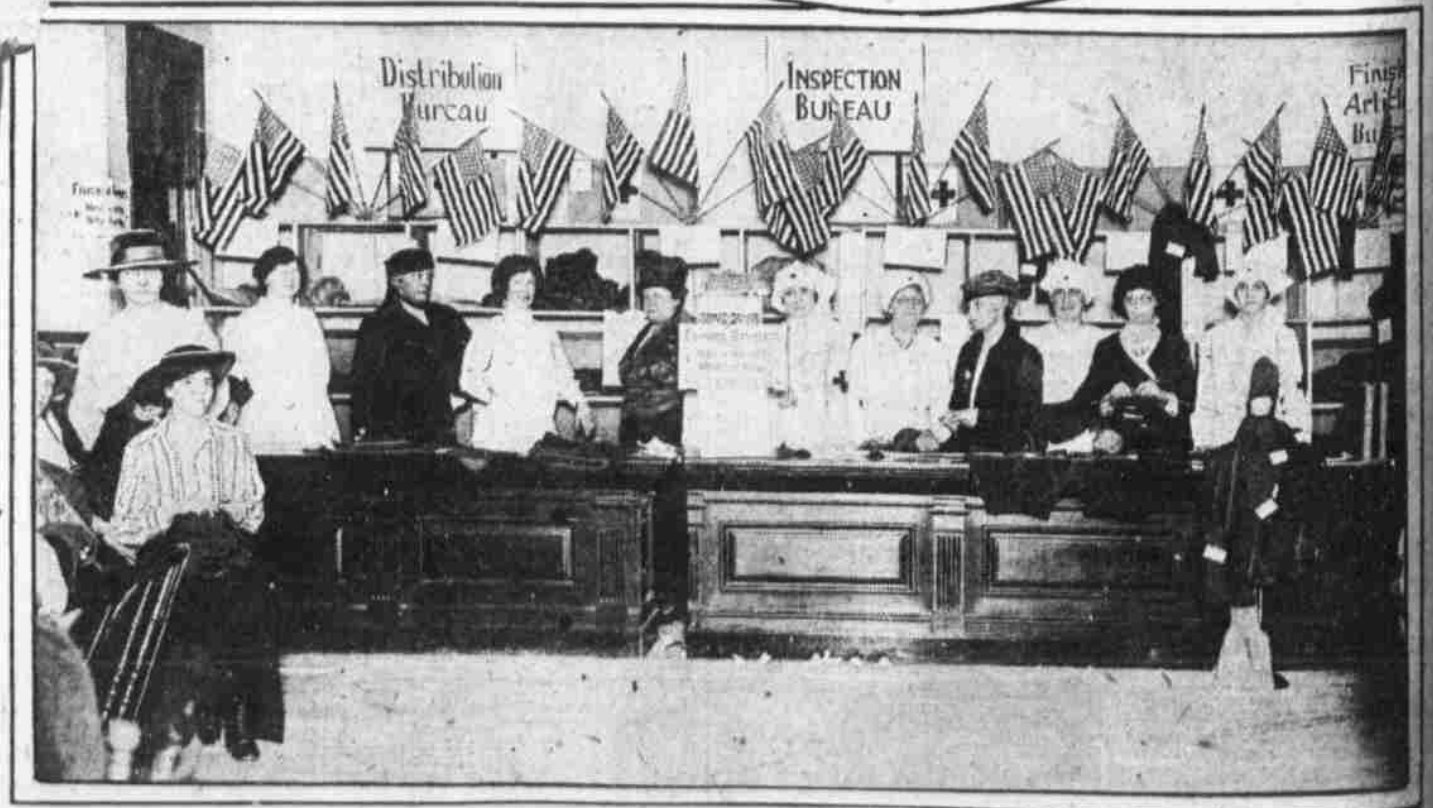


The Young Lady Across the Way
