TO DARKEN TWIN LAMPS AS FUEL CONSERVATION

A proposal to save the city much fuel and expense by burning only one light of the twin lamps that line the principal thoroughfares of the city was taken up today by the Electrical Bureau, officials of which stated that while it undoubtedly would result in a big saving of current, they could not estimate the benefits of hand. They said that it might possibly necessitate new, or changes of connections and other expense that they could not definitely estimate at this time.

There are 1453 of these twin lamps in the city, and their cost to the city is \$47.50 per lamp per year, resulting in a total cost to the city yearly of \$11,200.
