

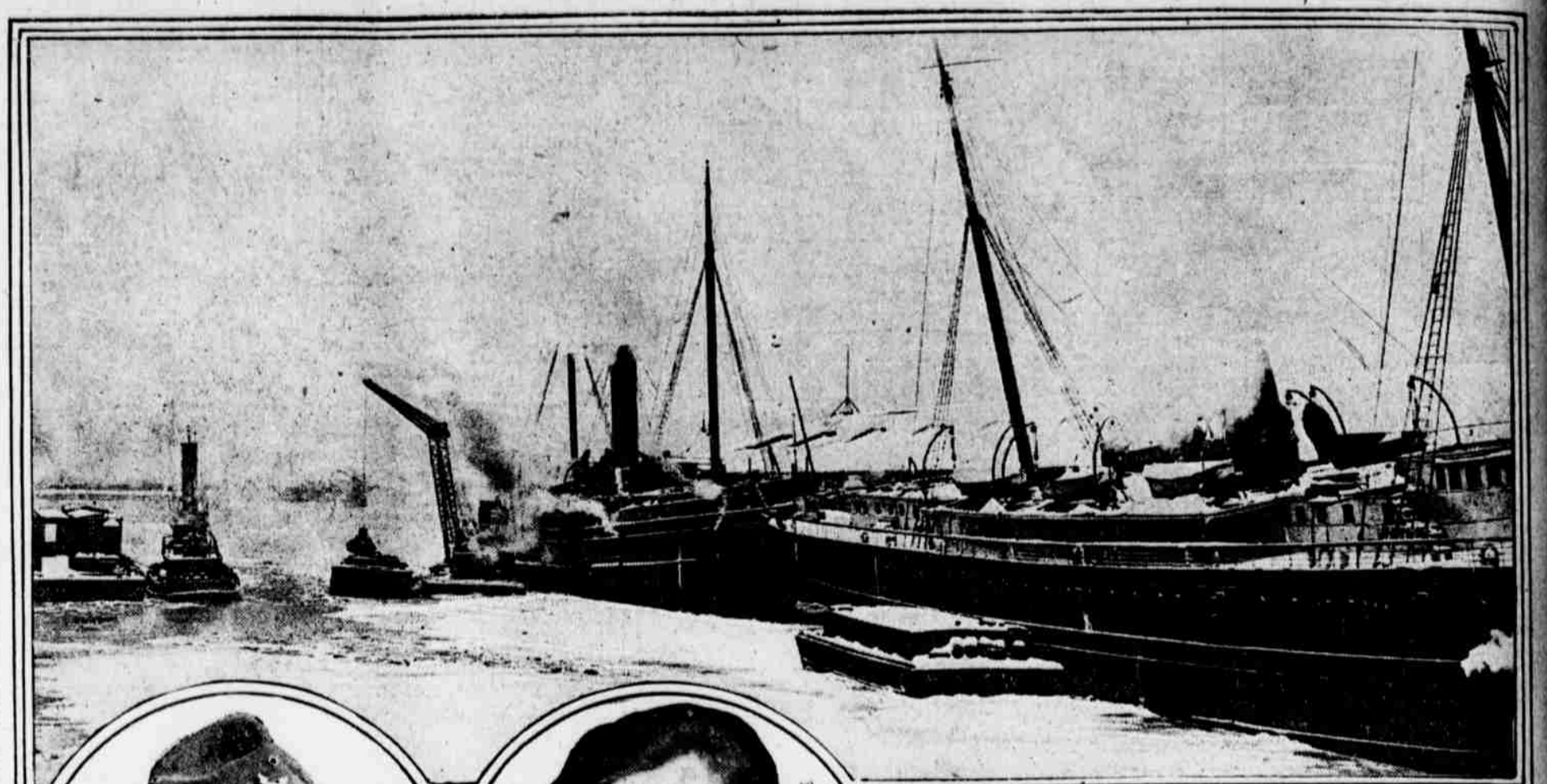

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Under a liberal blanket of snow Philadelphia's prosperous port has taken on the appearance of a Newfoundland harbor.

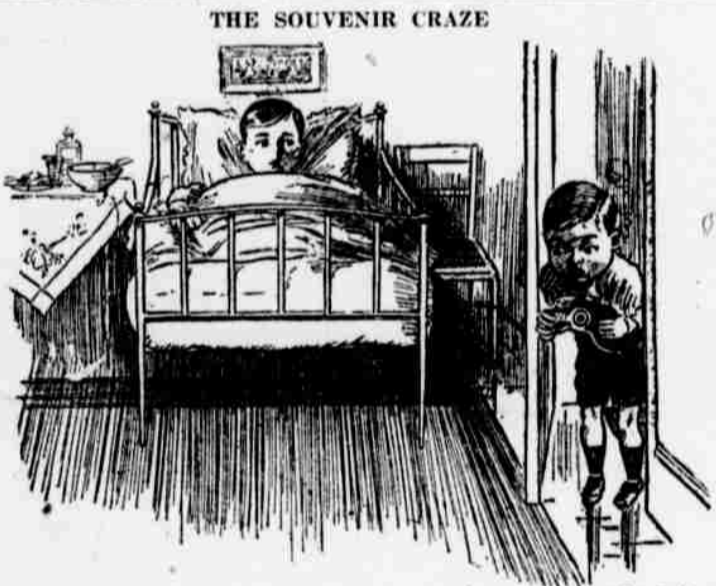

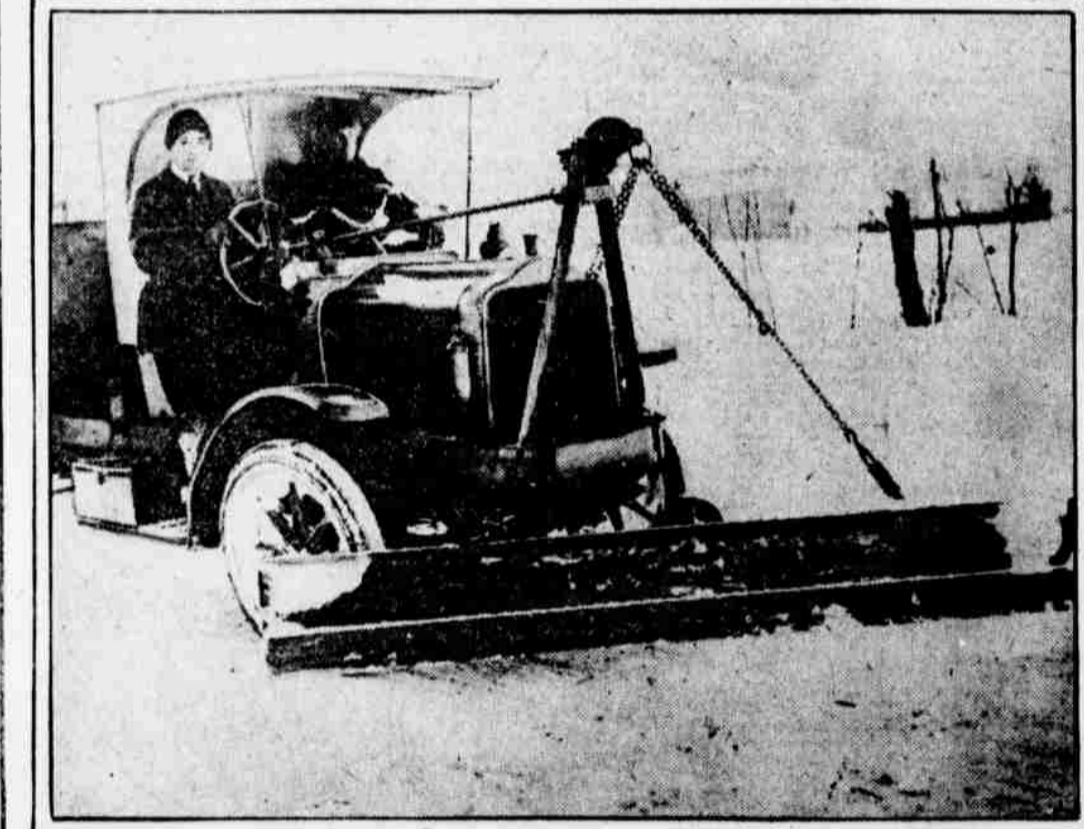

The Young Lady Across the Way



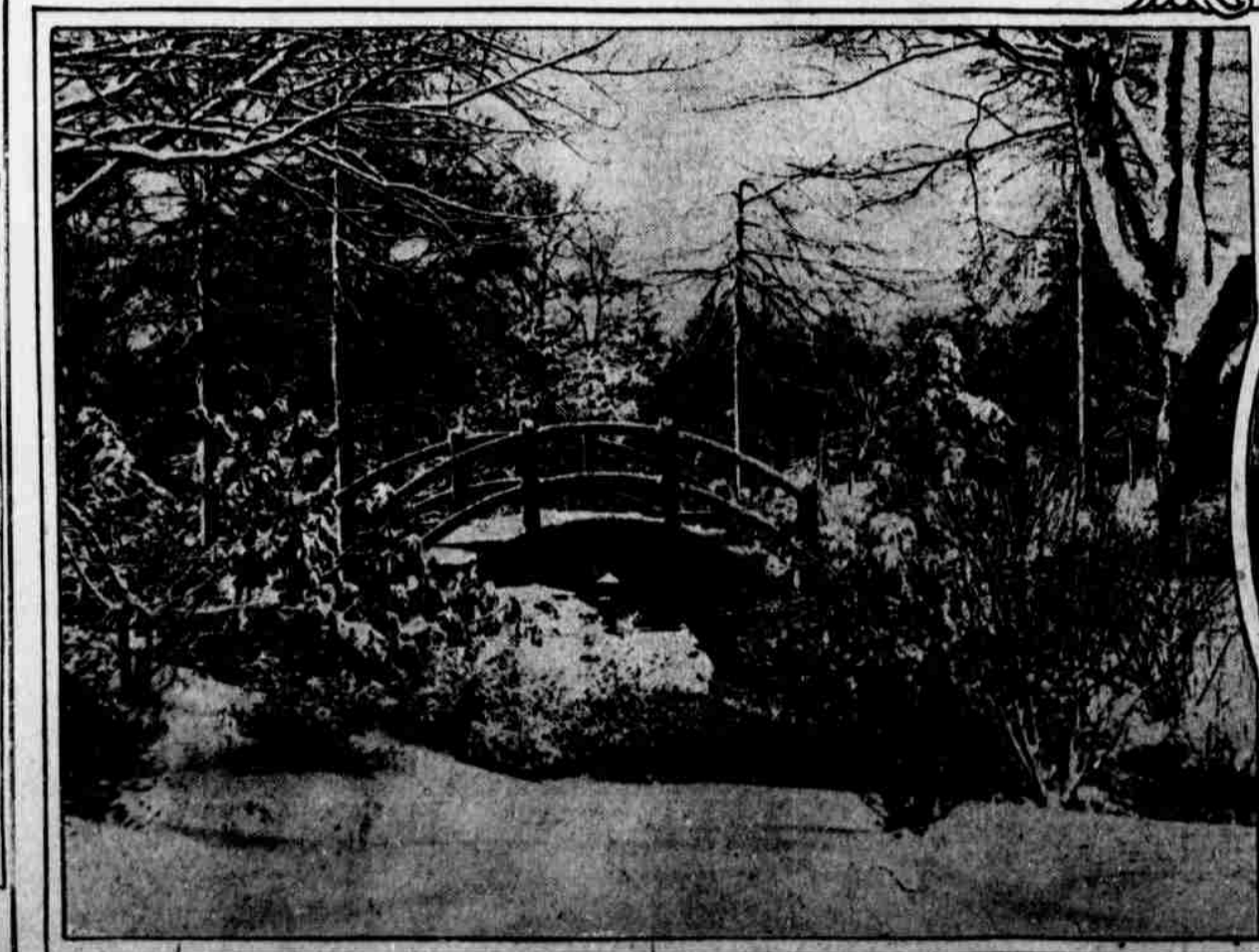
