Sees Need of Government Aid for Public Utilities

COMES HAVE BEEN OUT

Wants Finance Bill Stratched to Cover Point and Relieve Tension

WASHINGTON, Feb. 22.—President Wilson and Secretary McAdoo, through correspondence just made public, give assurance to public utilities corporations that every aid will be extended them to prevent their finances from reaching a state of bankruptcy.

According to officials in the Treasury Department, the financial condition of public utilities is grave. Their income virtually is limited through the legal prices they can charge, and in many cities the problem of meeting fixed charges is acute.

PLAN LOANS FROM U. S.

Ample powers to remedy the situation are contained in the war finance corporation bill, which may be stretched to cover the making of direct loans by the Treasury Department to public utilities in case the banks are unable to extend credit facilities, provided that the corporations have sufficient security for the loan.

PLAN CENTRAL BOARD

WASHINGTON, Feb. 22.—Systematic direction and control over the industries of the country is contemplated by the Administration.
