

GOSSIP OF THE STREET—PHILADELPHIA PRODUCE MARKETS

FINANCIERS GRAVELY CONCERNED OVER THE RUSSIAN SITUATION

Recent Events Cause Uneasiness Among Thinking Men Who Fear Serious Consequences of Collapse

There are very few in financial circles in Philadelphia who are not fully awake to the seriousness of the Russian situation, which is now creating much uneasiness in the minds of thinking men.

Townsend Whelan & Co., of Chestnut street near Fifth, said yesterday in reference to the subject: "It does not seem to us that the people of the country have realized the seriousness of the developments in the Russian situation."

In their regular weekly letter on general market observations (Chandler Bros & Co. devote more than a page to what the term "the Russian debacle" in which they take up the matter in a most exhaustive and serious manner.

There is also need of immediate action by Japan. There should be no denial of request by any honorable grant of territory by conquest or expense for its cooperation, via the Siberian route, before it is too late.

There are still no inconsiderable number of financiers who hold on to the belief that Russia is today a much greater menace to Germany than at any time during the war.

Only a few days ago most bankers and brokers were inclined to dismiss all discussion about Russia with the almost stereotyped expression that "Russia has long since ceased to be a factor in the war."
