ENLIST HIGH SCHOOL BOYS IN FARM WORK

Campaign Soon to Open Here. Government Will Give Help. Massachusetts as Example

High School boys of Philadelphia are being sounded to see how many of them will be ready to volunteer for farm work during the coming summer vacations.

Massachusetts there were about twenty camps last year where boys were treated for farm service. Funds were provided mainly by private subscription. Boys too young for military service but old enough and strong enough to work on the farm were enlisted by a committee assisted by Y. M. C. A. and school authorities.

Wages were paid to the boys by the farmers, and nearly all of them were advanced in pay before the end of the summer. All of them were benefited physically.
