Nipponese Prepare to Take Action to Protect Interests of Allies

AGREEMENT INDICATED

TOKIO, March 4. Bills authorizing the Minister of War to mobilize industry contributing to the prosecution of the war are to be introduced in the Diet, it was announced today.
