

OUR HUN PLANES DOWNED AT PARIS

Teuton Airmen Punished When 60 Machines Attack French Capital

U. S. WAR CHIEFS THERE

Berlin (via London), March 12.—"Paris was successfully bombed in retaliation for enemy air attacks Saturday and Sunday at Stuttgart, Esslingen, Untertuerkheim and Mai," the German War Office announced today.

Paris, March 12.—Four German airplanes were brought down in last night's air raid over Paris, it was officially announced today. No report was made regarding casualties or damage.

Sixty hostile machines, comprising perhaps the largest air fleet ever attacking Paris, tried to pierce the capital's defenses.

Some of them were driven off by French scouts and high angle fire before they could reach the city, but several got through and dropped bombs on Paris proper and the suburbs.

A few bombs were demolished and two were started.

An official communiqué issued early today stated that the number of victims was unknown at that hour.

The alarm was sounded shortly after 8 o'clock, but it was an hour before the machines appeared over the city and bombs began to fall. It was not until midnight that the "all clear" signal was given.

The raid and the fight in the air between French and German machines offered a thrilling scene for the American Secretary of War, Newton D. Baker, who had only arrived here yesterday morning and was spending his first night in the French capital.

Over a dozen falling bombs, the flashes of the guns, the bursting of shrapnel shells, high in the air and the glimpse of the fleet machines through the glares from numerous searchlights that continuously swept the sky gave Mr. Baker his first picture of the war at close range.

Mr. Baker is staying at the Hotel Crillon, along with the other members of his party.

General Pershing, the American commander-in-chief, and General Tasker H. Bliss, the American representative on the allied council, were at Versailles, had come home to meet Mr. Baker and to escort him to the American front and it is understood that they too were in the city during the raid.

The attack followed a raid made last Friday night, when thirteen persons were killed and fifty wounded in this city.

We need men very badly in France. I expect to see more marines landed in France shortly because of the shortage of American troops. We just can't get there quick enough. We must catch the men who are now circulating about in France—I know it to be a fact that the country—I am speaking of France—is a mess. We took four ships over on the boat on which I sailed when I went to the other side. There are spies everywhere, and you will also find them in the American army. It is useless to give a spy a trial. I can't understand what can prompt a man to become a spy for Germany—whether for money, for love of Germany, or for the general cussedness. My only regret is that after a month I should be put out of commission.

Gordon has a picture of a French captain whom he cherishes more than any souvenir he has from France.

The officer in question won numerous decorations. "If I could win half the medals this man did," said Gordon, "I would die gladly."

REV. Z. M. GIBSON ELECTED MODERATOR

Roxborough Pastor Chosen to Preside Over Presbytery of Philadelphia North

SHERIFFS. Pa., March 12.—The primary of Philadelphia North which met here today elected the Rev. Z. Montgomery Gibson, the Rev. Benjamin F. Palmer, moderator, to succeed the Rev. Jacob W. Krause, treasurer, who died last month. It is believed that Jacob W. Krause, treasurer of the Presbytery, was seriously ill and therefore absent.

The election of ministers and laymen were to be held at the Rev. John Allen Crawford, pastor of the church.

Minutes on the deaths of members who died since last meeting were adopted. Those included one in the Wright Craig, clerk of the United States District Court, who for forty years was an elder of the First Presbyterian Church, Norristown.

Rev. Wm. E. Barnes was received from the Huntingdon Presbytery to become pastor of the Homestead Church at a salary of \$1400 and parsonage and one month's vacation.

Rev. George W. Miller, his requested, was dismissed to the Ohio presbytery that he may become pastor of a church in Pittsburgh. He has been at Langhorne for fourteen years.

M'GOVERN QUITS RACE FOR WISCONSIN TOGA

Former Governor Will Back Lenroot Against La Follette's Candidate

MILWAUKEE, Wis., March 12.—Lines to meet Tuesday's battle for the Republican primary nomination for United States Senator in Wisconsin were drawn more sharply today as the result of the withdrawal from the race of Senator Francis M'Govern. He will devote himself to furthering the candidacy of Rep. Fred C. Iking Lenroot for the place vacated by the death of Senator Paul O. Hurlbut.

M'Govern's action leaves two Republicans as candidates. They are Senator James Thompson, who is said to have the support of Senator La Follette. Two Democratic candidates had launched their campaigns—Dr. Charles McCarthy and Joseph Davies, members of the Federal Trade Commission.

Victor Berger is unopposed for the Socialist nomination.
