Bull Operations Are Abandoned—Losses Range From 1 to 2 Points Throughout the List Before Midday Security news at last yielded to the influence of the continued disappointing news from the French battlefield, and in today's early trading there was an increase in volume of liquidation, which caused declines ranging from 1 to 2 points all through the list before midday.
