PROFESSIONALS STILL CONTROL TRADING ON THE N. Y. EXCHANGE Advances Follow Irregular Opening, but Gains Do Not Hold—Gulf States Steel Jumps 6 Points

New York, April 23.—The stock market was again left in the control of the professional element on the floor, important interests taking little part in the trading and the tone changed with each shifting of position by the room traders. At the beginning of business there was some irregularity, which was followed by a display of strength, when many stocks made gains ranging from fractions to around 1 point, with Gulf States Steel attracting attention by an advance of 6 points to 106.
