Members of the Federal vocational board are desirous that the training of the soldiers for new employment shall be left in their hands and that the military authority shall extend only to medical aid.

The present draft of the bill gives the War Department authority to retain a wounded man in the service and detail him to a vocational training school.

Senator Hoke Smith, of Georgia, who is in charge of the bill, declared today that he expected the bill would be re-drafted before it is brought up in either house.

The board decided to permit the adding of a war surcharge of ten cents per thousand cubic feet for gas and four-tenths of a cent per kilowatt hour for electric current, the new rates to be effective May 1.
