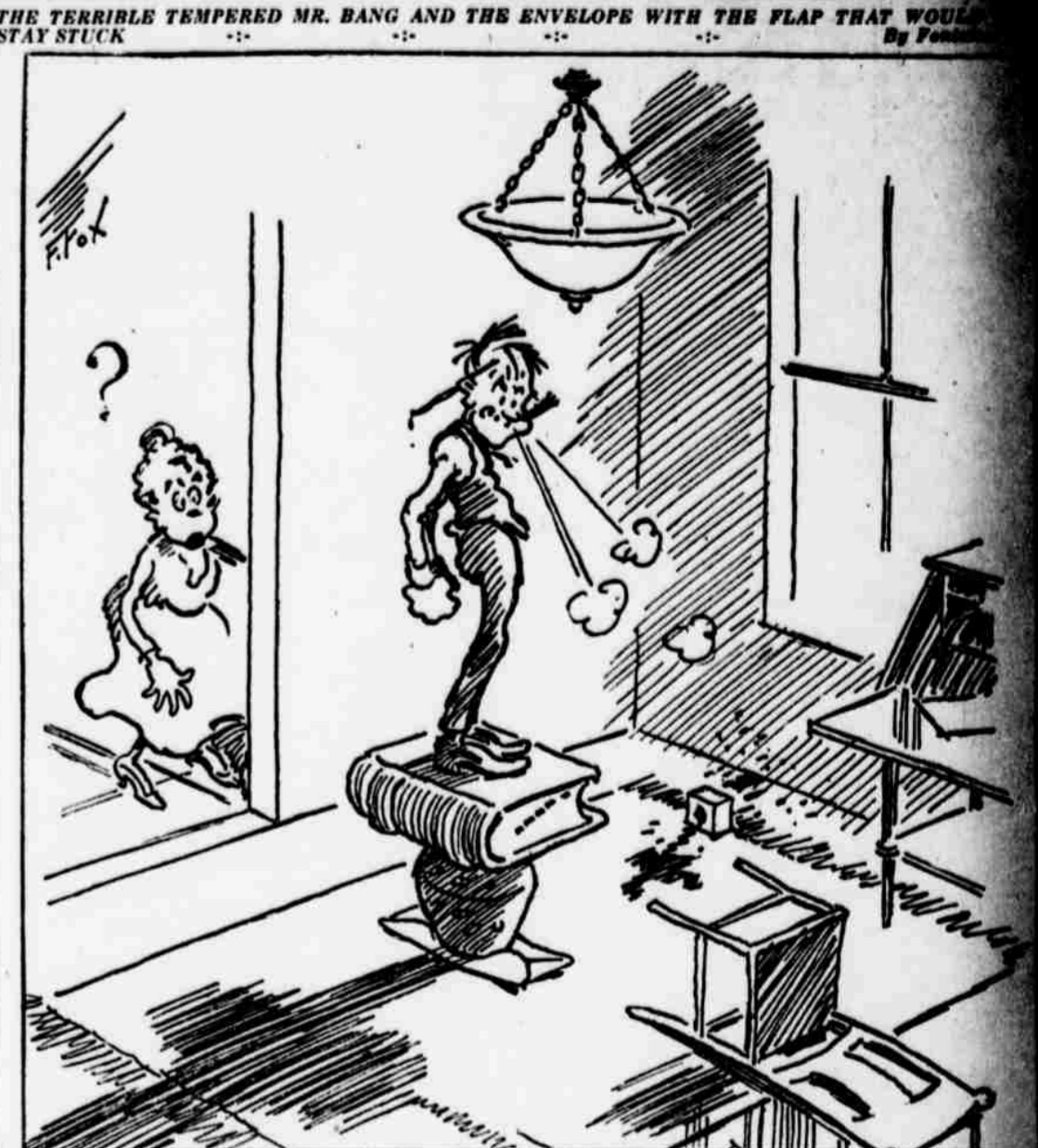
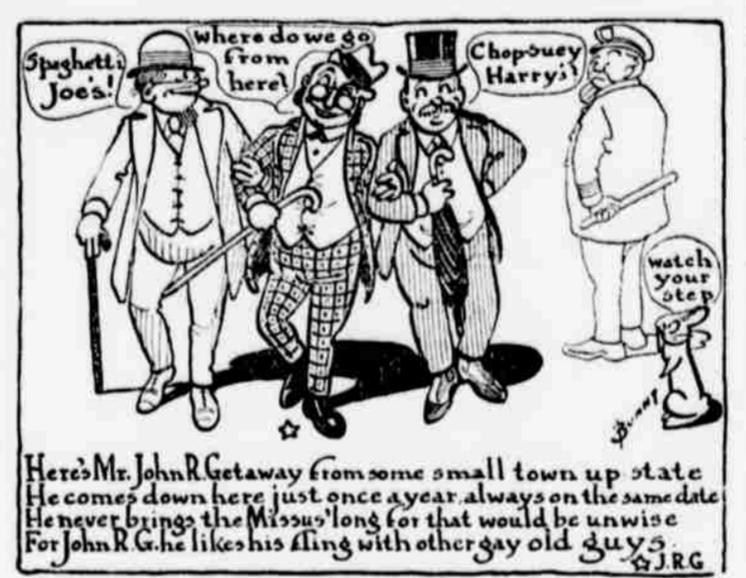
Such Is Life

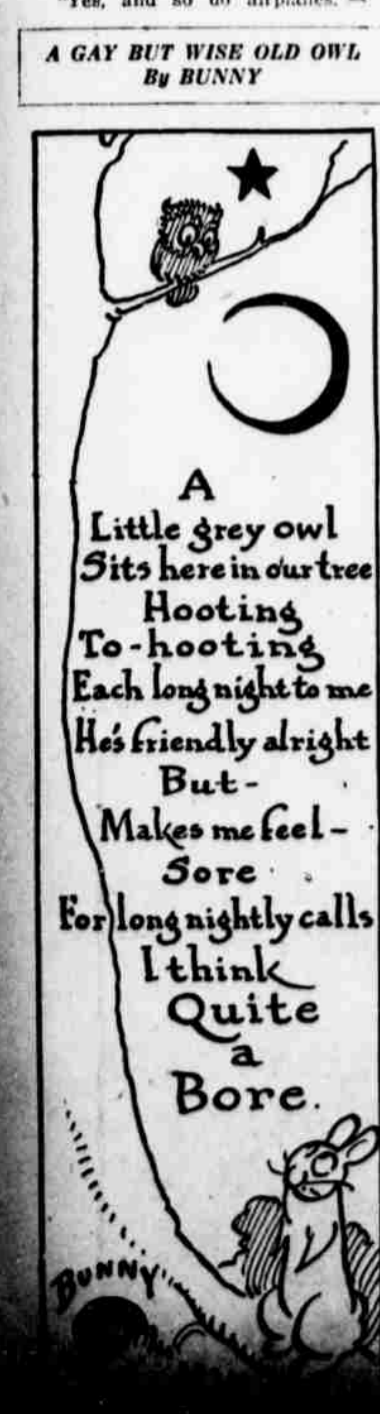

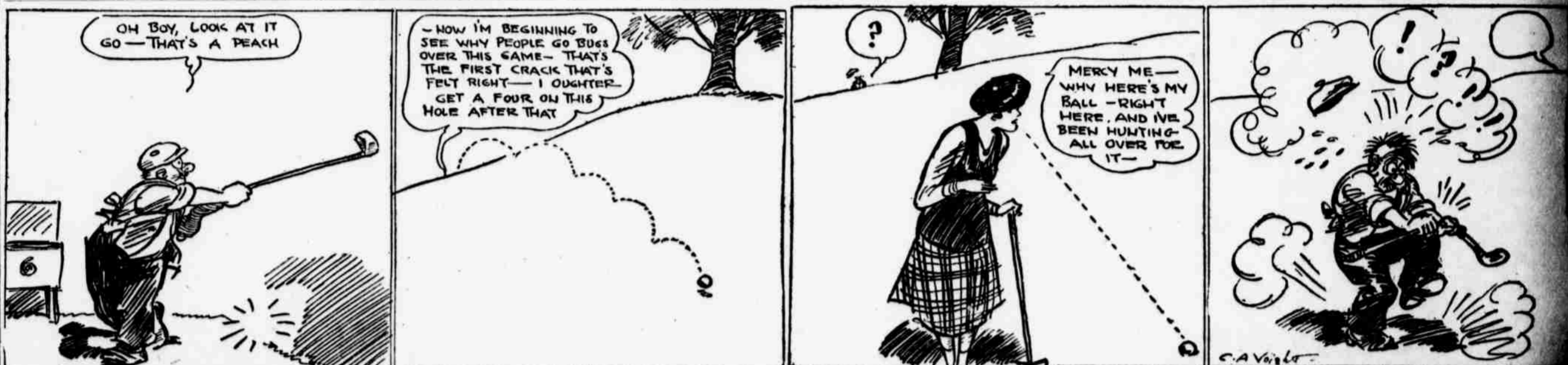
