

MEMORIAL DAY OBSERVANCE FOR DIX

Program Includes Athletic Meet in Afternoon and Other Events

Camp Dix, Wrightstown, N. J., May 18. Plans are being made here for the observance of Memorial Day and indications are that there will be something doing all day. In the afternoon there will be a big athletic meet under the direction of Sol Metzger, athletic director of the Y. M. C. A., and Frank Wandle, secretary of the Knights of Columbus, has arranged for a number of prominent wrestlers to come here, including several champions. In the evening he will take five of the camp's best boxers to Philadelphia to compete against the pick of the navy at a tournament to be held at the United Service Club in Philadelphia. An entertainment will also be held at the big open-air "Y" and an address will be given by a prominent speaker.

President John Grier Hibben, of Princeton University, will speak tomorrow and address the men of the 11th Infantry Brigade at the Y. M. C. A. auditorium. Chaplain J. P. Shidell, formerly chaplain of the Pacific-third United States Infantry, will speak to the men at huts 1 and 8.

The order barring visitors from the camp, which went into effect at midnight last night, will be continued in force until 6 p. m. Monday. The crowds that have been flowing in and out of camp all week have interfered greatly with military work, and it was deemed advisable to keep visitors out for several days. Whether or not it will be a permanent week-end order has not been announced as yet.
