BASEBALL'S FATE WAITS ON TEST CASE TO BE DECIDED BY A LOCAL BOARD

Some Indications Point to Disinclination of Officials to Stop National Pastime

Washington, May 23. Will the War Department continue organized baseball to working or nonworking draft raising agents to players?

That question took equal rank in popular discussion today with international and war problems.

Some indications pointed to a disinclination upon the part of the department to ban the national pastime even though some members would make excellent grounds throwers and other players could find well in the Florida, Florida league, or on the approaching line along the highway.

Deputies of the sport declared that baseball had not meant to live with the draft, but that it was now being introduced by the present national general's "work-night" order.

Magnates Calm. Baseball men in the big leagues are facing the new situation calmly. They stand ready to do whatever the government demands, but they are not yet ready to feel that the closing of a sport would be a blow to the nation.

The War Department was understood to have a number of suggestions in the quarters that organized leagues will be permitted to make out their own rules without too great interference from outside of the military.

There are, however, many who feel that the War Department has been too hasty in its decision to make the draft of a baseball or could be leaving it in the hands of the draft board.
