

NEW HAVEN AND ERIE PRESIDENTS REMOVED

Federal Managers Take Over Operation of Railroads. Ashton Director in West

Washington, June 12.—Among the railroad executives removed as chief operating officers of their roads by appointment of Federal managers to operate lines for the railroad administration are Howard Elliott, of the New Haven, and F. D. Underwood, of the Erie. Both will remain heads of their respective companies, however, and their salaries will be paid out of corporate funds, rather than from operating receipts accruing to the Government.

New York, June 12.—Announcement is made here of the resignation of R. H. Ashton as executive, director and member of the executive committee of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway Company. The reason is his appointment as regional director of western railroads. W. H. Finley has been elected to succeed him. Mr. Ashton resigned also as a director of the Chicago, St. Paul, Minneapolis and Omaha Railway Company. His successor has not been selected.

Washington, June 12.—The railroad administration has authorized increase from six to seven cents in the fare from New York to Newark, a distance of nine miles over the Hudson and Manhattan tube route and the Pennsylvania Railroad. This will make east-bound rates the same, although yesterday when the new passenger rates went into effect the Pennsylvania sold east-bound tickets at twenty-seven cents, while the Hudson and Manhattan, forbidden by Director General McAdoo to raise rates, sold west-bound tickets at the old price of twenty-seven cents. Railroads operating ferries between New Jersey points and Manhattan and Brooklyn have received permission from the Interstate Commerce Commission to raise their rates five cents, although this increase will not be put into effect until after the railroad administration investigates to determine whether it is necessary.

When the car reached the end of the line at Fort Lee he was arrested and placed in jail overnight.
