

BRITISH NAVAL FLIERS ATTACK DESTROYERS

Bomb German Warships and Deluge Them With Fire From Machine Guns

London, July 19.—The following official communication has been issued by the admiralty dealing with the navy's recent activities.

"During the period from July 11 to 17, inclusive, royal air force units, working with the navy in home waters, have maintained the anti-submarine and escort patrols.

"Our formations also have attacked destroyers with machine gun fire. On one of these occasions, five enemy seaplanes approached at the beginning of the action, but immediately withdrew.

"Enemy aircraft have been active and have attacked our bombing and patrol formations. Three hostile machines have been destroyed or driven down out of control.

"One of our anti-submarine patrol formations observed an enemy submarine on the 17th. There were no occupants of it.
