

OBJECTORS FROM DIX ARE SENT TO FARMS

All but Six Cases Disposed Of. Two Deserters Get Heavy Sentences. Camp Dix, Wrightstown, N. J., Aug. 17. Among the thousands of men now stationed at Camp Dix there are about only six conscientious objectors, and it is expected that their cases will be disposed of in the near future, so that the cantonment officials will only have to take care of the cases that come in each day. The reason for the reduction in the number is the order from the War Department allowing the furloughing of the real objectors for work on farms, and in this way Dix was able to release about thirty-five men for this sort of labor. The men must agree to work continuously on the farms to which they are assigned, and failure to perform their duty means that they will face a court-martial board. Two deserters were summarily dealt with by the court-martial board that heard their cases here. One, Private Clyde M. Ward, of the detachment at the school for bakers and cooks, was given a term of ten years, and the other, Private Clarence Bookman, of the Pioneers, was given twenty years because he also faced an additional charge, which was later not substantiated, of wearing civilian clothes while a deserter. Ward gave himself up at his home town, Fort Wayne, Ind., while Bookman was apprehended at Fort Dupont, Del. A. B. Meredith, assistant director of educational work in the State of New Jersey, who is at Dix during the month of August aiding in the work of educating the non-English-speaking objectors, is now stationed at the Y. M. headquarters, and during the temporary absence of H. A. Townsend, educational director, will have full charge of the work in camp. Among the latest secretaries to join the Jewish welfare workers here is Max Schiebstein, of Philadelphia, who lost his right arm while performing military duty on the Mexican border with General Pershing. During one of the uprisings at Brownsville he was thrown from his horse and his arm broken in such a way that amputation was necessary. He was discharged from the service last January and a short time ago entered the training school for welfare workers. A handsome show was given last evening at the Dix Theatre by the men of the Eighth Battalion of the depot brigade, and will be repeated this evening. The proceeds will be turned over to the hospital fund. The men of the Second Battalion are planning to present "It Pays to Advertise" in the near future.
