Within a few weeks after Moran started his salvaging activities he systematized the work to such an extent, he says, that he could in twenty minutes tell his men how to put in their whole day, and then his own day's work was virtually done.

Improvements have been made to the Chester Shipyard Hospital, which make it one of the best-equipped and most modern places of the kind in the country.

Full treatment is given there in cases of minor injuries, but owing to lack of room the more serious ones are removed to the Chester City Hospital.

All acute attacks of illness while on duty are attended to in the yard hospital. The monthly average of casuals treated at the hospital runs up around 4000.

In two years only two legs, one arm and one finger have been sacrificed at the yard. Many compound fractures and dislocations are treated there.
