UPWARD MOVEMENT STARTS ON NEW YORK STOCK EXCHANGE

Money Situation Has Eased Up to Such an Extent That Many Brokers Lend Instead of Borrowing. No Pressure Indicated

Marked improvement was shown in securities trading from a period soon after the opening this morning, when an upward movement started, causing vigorous advances in many issues. The money situation has apparently cleared up to a material extent, and instead of brokers seeking banking accommodation, many of the larger commission houses are now in the market as lenders of money, causing an excessive supply, with a condition created of money being more plentiful than stocks.

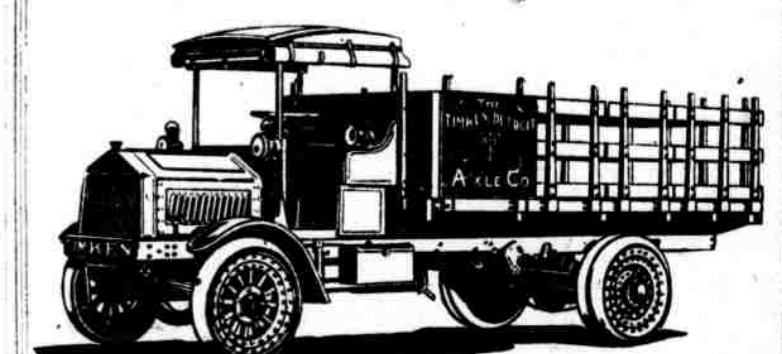
